OPPOSE A.B. 2223 **Prohibiting Infant Death Investigations**

A.B. 2223 will put babies and women at high risk of injury and abuse in the name of "women's healthcare."

Formerly known as "The Infanticide Bill," A.B. 2223 states that a person will not be "subject to civil or criminal liability or penalty" based on their actions "with respect to their pregnancy or actual, potential, or alleged pregnancy outcome, including miscarriage, stillbirth, or abortion, or perinatal death due to a cause that occurred in utero." "Perinatal" can be defined as a number of weeks after birth.

Even after amendments made by the author, A.B. 2223 remains one of the most dangerous bills in CA legislation, shielding mothers (and those who aid her) from prosecution of fetal and perinatal deaths due to drug-use during pregnancy, "back-alley abortions," and botched abortions, while making it difficult to investigate abuse, partial-birth abortions, and even infanticide.

A.B. 2223 goes beyond any other pro-abortion bill to undermine the value of life and place women in harm's way.
