John 1:1-4, 9-14

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men... 9 That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. 10 He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. 11 He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. 12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: 13 who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. 14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Picking up where we left off last week in our Christmas Series regarding the foretold Advent of Almighty God coming to Earth in Human skin - into this world where we "claim to live" but really only seek to exist because frankly - - life without Jesus isn't really living!

The Meaning of the Word Invincible

Incapable / Unable to be overcome, defeated or conquered. Incapable / Unable to be subdued, arrested, or held captive. Incapable / Unable to be stopped, die or to killed.

It's Jesus Christ Who Stands Invincible

3a.) By His invincible power

Colossians 1:15-16

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. 16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

Romans 11:36

For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen.

Matthew 28:18-19

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name,

Luke 2:6-14

So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. 7 And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. 8 Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. 9 An behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. 10 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. 11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. 12 And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger." 13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: 14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!"

4c.) By His unchanging love

1 John 4:7b God is love.

Love Made Known

Jesus was cancelled, shamed & made fun of

Matthew 27:28-31

And they stripped Him and put a scarlet robe on Him. 29 When they had twisted a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand. And they bowed the knee before Him and mocked Him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" 30 Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head. 31 And when they had mocked Him, they took the robe off Him, put His own clothes on Him, and led Him away to be crucified.

Jesus suffered thirst just like us

John 19:28

After this, Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, "I thirst!"

Jesus suffered being exhausted just like us

John 4:6

Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied from His journey, sat thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.

Jesus suffered being misunderstood just like us

John 8:42b-43

For I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me. 43 Why do you not understand My speech? Because you are not able to listen to My word.

Jesus suffered hunger just like us

Matthew 4:1-3

Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. 2 And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry. 3 Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."

Jesus wept just like us

John 11:35 Jesus wept.

Jesus suffered for us so that we could know that He suffered so we could find comfort knowing – that He knows what we're going through.
