Why ?

Acts 1:1-3

The former account I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, **2** until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen, **3** to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by **many infallible proofs**, being **seen** by them during forty days and **speaking** of the things **pertaining to the kingdom of God.**

grk: po'lus

in abundance, many as in the extreme, in the greatest amount of,
in overwhelming numbers.

John 10:10b

I HAVE COME that they may have life,
and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

Theses Many Infallible Proofs

John 20:30-31

And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; **31** but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

John 21:25

And there are also many other things that Jesus did, which if they were written one by one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that would be written. Amen.

Infallible grk: eh'le'ne'kah
undeniable, conclusive, incontrovertible, irrefutable, unable to disprove.

Acts 1:3b NLT

...And He **proved** to them in many ways that He was actually alive. And He **talked to them** about the Kingdom of God.

Proofs grk: tek'me'ri'on
markers, indicators, signs, assurances, (blatant or obvious hints)

2 Peter 1:12-17

For this reason, I will not be negligent to remind you always of these things, though you know and are established in the present truth. **13** Yes, I think it is right, as long as I am in this tent, to stir you up by reminding you, **14** knowing that shortly I *must* put off my tent, just as our Lord Jesus Christ showed me. **15** Moreover I will be careful to ensure that you always have a reminder of these things after my decease. **16** For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty. **17** For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

Isaiah 7:14

Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name **Immanuel**.

Why The Office of a King?

2 Samuel 7:16

(Here Nathan Speaks to David)

And **your house** and your **kingdom** shall be established **forever** before you.
Your **throne** shall be established **forever**. ” ’ ”

A King Must Have a Kingdom.

Luke 1:31-33

And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS. **32**
He will be great, and will be called the Son of **the Highest**; and the Lord God will give Him the **throne**

of His father David. 33 And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

8.) Why – Christmas Is a New Testament

Christmas is a {Traditional} Holy Day that is Set Apart
To acknowledge the Coming of the Messiah for
The Redemption of Mankind.

Jeremiah 31:31

"Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah

The definition of a Testament is rather extensive;

It is an agreement between two or more parties that is created by the living Testator, ordering their physical assets in such a way that they become to those surviving. Testament is a creed or declaration of belief based upon the evidence and the tangible reasons for belief. To declare one's convictions based upon the evidence and truth obtained.

Hebrews 9:11,14-15a,16-17

But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation, 14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience

from dead works to serve the living God? **15c** And for this reason He is the Mediator of the **new covenant**, by means of death, **16** For where there is a testament, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. **17** For a testament is in force after men are dead, since it has no power at all while the testator lives.

1 Corinthians 15:20a

But now Christ is risen from the dead,

Luke 22:20

Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying,
"This cup is the **new covenant** in My blood, which is shed for you.

Hebrews 8:7-8

For if that first covenant had been faultless, then no place would have been sought for a second. **8** Because finding fault with them, He says: *"Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a **new covenant** with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah.*

Matthew 25:31

"When the Son of Man comes **IN HIS GLORY**, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the **throne** of His glory.

Revelation 19:11-16

Now I **(John)** saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him **was called** Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

12 His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. **13** He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, **(Tribulation Blood)** and His name **is called** The Word of God. **14** And

THE ARMIES IN HEAVEN, CLOTHED IN FINE LINEN, WHITE AND CLEAN, followed Him on white horses.

15 Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will **rule** them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. **16** And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: **KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.**

Use Oil of Simeon at The Temple by Rembrandt

Luke 2:25-33

And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for **The Consolation of Israel**, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. **26** And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ. **27** So he came by the Spirit into the temple. And when the parents brought in the Child Jesus, to do for Him according to the custom of the law, **28** he took Him up in his arms and blessed God and said: **29** *"Lord, now You are letting Your servant depart in peace, according to Your word; **30** for my eyes have seen Your salvation **31** which You have prepared before the face of all peoples, **32** A light to bring revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of Your people Israel."* **33** And Joseph and His mother marveled at those things which were spoken of Him.

Written in 1745, - Charles Wesley sums this up beautifully.
In his Immortal hymn.

Come, Thou long-expected Jesus / Born to set Thy people free;
From our fears and sins release us / Let us find our rest in Thee.
Israel's Strength and Consolation / Hope of all the earth Thou art;
Dear Desire of every nation / Joy of every longing heart.
