Romans 1:1-6

Paul, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, CALLED TO BE an apostle, separated to the Gospel of God 2 which He promised before through His prophets in the Holy Scriptures, 3 concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh, 4 and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead. 5 Through Him we have received grace and apostleship for obedience to the faith among all nations for His name, 6 among whom *(the nations of this world)* you also are the called of Jesus Christ;

“His divine plan is independent of time. Do not dream Christian that the ages have changed, so that in this day God cannot do his mighty works. Beloved, if you can conceive of an age that is worse than another, so much the more is it a fit platform for heavenly energy; the more difficult, the more room for Omnipotence to show Himself; there is elbow room for the great God when there is some great thing in the way, - some great difficulty that he may overturn.” – C.H. Spurgeon

or Idea On Our Part. This is Not Some “Self Help” or “Positive Attitude” Course.**

The Galvanizing Force Is = We Preach Christ...

1 Corinthians 1:20-24

Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this age?

Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? 21 For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, it pleased God through the foolishness of the message PREACHED to save those who believe. 22 For Jews desire a sign, and Gentiles seek after wisdom; 23 but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness, 24 but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, CHRIST the power of God and the wisdom of God.

“Called To Be” A New Voice

2a.) We speak what we know

vs. 2a

Verse 2a

2 which He promised
before (*or beforehand – in advance of*)

Isaiah 46:10

10 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things that are not yet done, Saying, (promised word) “My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My pleasure,’

To You Who Are Not Yet Followers of Jesus Christ.

You Should Know Something – We Speak What We Know Because We've Been Convinced.

"Called To Be" A New Voice

2b.) We speak what we hear

vs. 2b

Through His prophet's -- in the Holy Scriptures,

We've Heard the Bible Speak (1) to the innermost person of who we are.
We've Heard the Bible Speak (2) to the thoughts and the motives behind your actions.
We've Heard the Bible Speak (3) to the emptiness and loneliness you battle with.
We've Heard the Bible Speak (4) to the insecurities and fears that enslave you.
We've Heard the Bible Speak (5) to the guilt and shame of our sins.

"Called To Be" A New Voice

2c.) We speak what we learn

vs. 3

Verse 3

3 concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord,
who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh,

The Power of a Personal Testimony, Your Testimony.

- (ie. John 9 "I once was blind but now I see")
- (ie. Mark 7 "I once could not speak, but now I can")
- (ie. John 11 "I once was dead, but now I'm alive")

John 11:43-44

Now when He had said these things, Jesus cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!" 44 And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Loose him, and let him go."

3.) A new power

vs. 4

Verse 4

4 and declared to be the Son of God with power
according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.

3a.) Powered by the message

vs. 4a

“Declared to be the Son of God.”

this is what is known as an Incarnational term.

Meaning: it has always been true of Christ, but at a set time was manifested or revealed.

Declared grk: horizo; to mark off or set as a boundary, a predetermined, premeditated appointment to announce (incarnation).

**Our Message is - God has come to us!
This is the “Incarnation”
It was Deity entering into the world in human flesh.**

John 1:14

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us,

The Christmas Incarnation

Luke 1:30-33

Then the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. 31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS. 32 He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. 33 And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.”

A holy huddle for sure

1 Timothy 3:16 NLT

Without question, this is the great mystery of our faith. Christ was revealed in a human body and vindicated by the Spirit. He was seen by angels and announced to the nations. He was believed in throughout the world and taken (*back*) to heaven in glory.

Luke 2:10-11,13-14

3b.) Powered by the source

vs. 4b

Verse 4

4b according to the Spirit of holiness,

This is the work of the Spirit of God. The Power Source is the Holy Spirit.

The Book of Acts 1:8

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

The Salvation Source is the Holy Spirit.

2 Corinthians 3:17

Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

The Sanctifying Source is the Holy Spirit.

Romans 8:29-30

For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. 30 Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.

The Keeping Source is the Holy Spirit.

Jude 1:24

Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy, power, both now and forever. Amen.

Keep grk: phulasso; to guard over, to be watched over / having another being fixed upon you, to preserve, to accomplish, to set to completion.

Psalm 138:8

The LORD will perfect that which concerns me; Your mercy, O LORD, endures forever; do not forsake the works of Your hands.

Philippians 1:6

Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

3c.) Powered by the purpose

vs. 4c

Verse 4c

4c by the resurrection from the dead.

The Greatest, Single Most Powerful Reality, that Proves
the Deity of Jesus Christ - is the fact that He rose from the dead

If Jesus is “Back from the Dead” –
what can you possibly be afraid of?

Acts 2:22-25

“Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst, as you yourselves also know - 23 Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death; 24 whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death, because it was not possible that He should be held by it. 25 For David says concerning Him: (*quoting Psalm 16:8*)

Acts 13:32-33

And we declare to you glad tidings—that promise which was made to the fathers. 33 God has fulfilled this for us their children, in that He has raised up Jesus. As it is also written in the second Psalm: “You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.’ (*quoting Psalm 2:7*)

Verse 5a

5 Through Him we have received
grace and apostleship

Divine **enablement** is the point here
This “Through Him - we have received...”

receive grk: lambano collected, gathered up, taken hold of, obtained.

grace grk: charis; a divine act of favor, an appointed kindness, a specific blessing.

apostleship grk: apostole; the sending away of a messenger, to go forth, to depart, to embark upon or to be commissioned to.

“Called To Be” A New Work

4b.) A new work of life	vs. 5b

Verse 5b

:5b for obedience to the faith
among all nations for His name,

Our witness is the point here.

“Faith is our response to what God has said and done.”
We have {life to give away}

We have the gift of eternal life so give the gift of eternal life.

2 Corinthians 4:7

But we have this treasure in earthen vessels,
that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.

nations grk: ethnos; the human race of peoples, humanity.

2 Corinthians 2:15-16

For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing. 16 To the one we are the aroma of death leading to death, and to the other the aroma of life leading to life. And who is sufficient for these things?

“Called To Be” A New Work

4c.) A new work of confidence

vs. 6

Verse 6

6 among whom you also
are the called of Jesus Christ;

Divine appointment is the key here

I will fail at what I am trying to convince you of;
But here goes...

You are called of Jesus Christ to know ***His will for your life***

You are called of Jesus Christ to know ***His purpose for your life***

You are called of Jesus Christ to know ***His joy for your life***

You are called of Jesus Christ to know ***His desire for your life***

You are called of Jesus Christ to know ***His joy for your life***

Philippians 2:13

For it is God who works in you
both to will and to do for His good pleasure.
