What then shall we say that Abraham our father has found according to the flesh? 2 For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. 3 For what does the Scripture say? "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." 4 Now to him who works, the wages are not counted as grace but as debt. 5 But to him who does not work but believes on Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is accounted for righteousness, 6 just as David also describes the blessedness of the man to whom God imputes righteousness apart from works: 7 "Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered; 8 Blessed is the man to whom the LORD shall not impute sin."

Genesis 17:4-8

“As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you (Abraham), and you shall be a father of many (Goy) nations. 5 No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many (Goy) nations. 6 I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations (Goy) of you, and kings shall come from you. 7 I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you. 8 (the origin of the promise) I give to you and your descendants after you the land in which you are a stranger, all the land of Canaan, (Israel) as an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.”

So Then, Whose God is He?

He is The God of The Nations beginning with Israel first.

**Accounted** grk: logizomai

to reckon, the counting, to credit with, to apply or to deposit into your account.

**Once Faith Takes Hold – An Explosion of Results Follows !**

James 2:20-24

But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead? 21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar? 22 Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect? 23 And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, “Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.” And he was called the friend of God. 24 You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only.

“Because Faith Works. Faith = Works.

Never Does Works = Faith.

Once after birth, the two are inseparable.”

**Belief must become faith – faith will become reality**

Romans 10:14-17

How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? 15 And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!” 16 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, “LORD, who has believed our report?” 17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

**The Power & Supremacy of The Scriptures**

#### Luke 24:1-27

Now on the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they, and certain other women with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. 2 But they found the stone rolled away from the tomb. 3 Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. 4 And it happened, as they were greatly perplexed about this, that behold, two men stood by them in shining garments. 5 Then, as they were afraid and bowed their faces to the earth, they said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? 6 He is not here, but is risen! Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, 7 saying, "The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.' " :8 And they remembered His words. 9 Then they returned from the tomb and told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest. 10 It was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and the other women with them, who told these things to the apostles. 11 And their words seemed to them like idle tales, and they did not believe them. 12 But Peter arose and ran to the tomb; and stooping down, he saw the linen cloths lying by themselves; and he departed, marveling to himself at what had happened. :13 Now behold, two of them were traveling that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was seven miles from Jerusalem. 14 And they talked together of all these things which had happened. 15 So it was, while they conversed and reasoned, that Jesus Himself drew near and went with them. 16 But their eyes were restrained, so that they did not know Him. 17 And He said to them, "What kind of conversation is this that you have with one another as you walk and are sad?" 18 Then the one whose name was Cleopas answered and said to Him, "Are You the only stranger in Jerusalem, and have You not known the things which happened there in these days?" :19 And He said to them, "What things?" So they said to Him, "The things concerning Jesus of Nazareth, who was a Prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, 20 and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and crucified Him. 21 But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed, besides all this, today is the third day since these things happened. 22 Yes, and certain women of our company, who arrived at the tomb early, astonished us. 23 When they did not find His body, they came saying that they had also seen a vision of angels who said He was alive. 24 And certain of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said; but Him they did not see." :25 Then He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! 26 Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?" 27 And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.

vs. 4

**Verse 4**

4 Now to him who works,  
the wages are not counted as grace but as debt.

**Works** grk: ergazomai  
seeks to accomplish, seeks to achieve, to commit to, one who labors to do, to perform, practice, repeat, seeks to trade or to barter.

**Wages** grk: misthos  
pay, earnings, rate, compensation, terms of.

**Debt** grk: opheilema  
to be owed to, an act requiring payment.

2c.) Salvation is a radical transformer

vs. 5

**Verse 5**

5 But to him who does not work but believes on Him who justifies  
the ungodly, his faith is accounted for righteousness,

**I HAVE A REALLY BIG QUESTION(S) FOR YOU**

Notice the obvious here, according to the Bible the ungodly can become godly. But how does that happen?

It's not his faith that makes him righteous – because faith how, is what you place in an object or in a person - - the object of Abrahams faith was God.

**Again, a Question for You:  
“Before Abram was changed into Abraham –**

**What happened to him for that to take place?  
( How did Abram get a new name? A new life and new God? )**

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ (atoned for), he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Colossians 2:9-10

For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; 10 and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.
