For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. 7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. 10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. 11 And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

# We've made our way through Romans 4 and we're well into our study in chapter 5. These 2 chapters display what many believe to be the greatest revelation of doctrinal truth regarding man's salvation, redemption & reconciliation to God

## The very thought of reconciliation is such a deep-seated need

for us as humans. We long to have our relationships healthy and happy and when they are – we flourish!!!

That said, each of us know that there is one relationship that ought to be healthy and happy above all others and that is our relationship with God.

#### Job 16:21

Oh, that one might plead for a man with God, as a man pleads for his neighbor!

### And in that great book of Job,

Job expressed his frustration with what he knew was a void between himself and God. That void he felt was the separation that exists between man and God because we are of a different nature – S.I.N.+

### Isaiah 59:1-2

Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; nor His ear heavy, that it cannot hear. 2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; and your sins have hidden His face from you, so that He will not hear.

If you were to {total up} the entire message of the Bible it would be this - That God has provided the Way of Redemption at His own expense for the Human Race.

"Beauty is in the eye of the beholder"?"

(1) Physical Attraction. (geometry) (2) Emotional Compatibility. (mind / soul) (3) Intellectual Cohesion. (relatability) (4) Life Experience. (bonding)

(any arrangement of these combinations are keys to any relationship)

I point this out from the human perspective to show how flawed we are. In every one of these 4 keys, our natural, human eyes cannot see God in that light because we cannot see God in His light.

#### **Demonstrates**

grk: sunistao sunistano / sunistemi to commend, to introduce or to announce, to put on exhibit, to approve of, put on display (positive).

He Displays His Own Love Toward Us, and this is what He wants you to know about His love for you...

while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

### Romans 8:7

Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be.

- (1) Physical attraction. (He's Invisible) (2) Emotional connection. (my will)
- (3) Intellectual cohesion. (don't understand) (4) Life experience. (pain, sorrow)

### John 3:16

For God so loved the world that He gave (displayed) His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

gave grk: didomi

granted, provided, gifted, revealed, put on display

For God so loved the world that He {granted} {provided {gifted} {revealed} {displayed} His one and only Son...

{God's own love toward us is Infinite}

{God's own love toward us is Unconditional}

{God's own love toward us is Appointed love}

His display was, is - so spectacular that unless our understanding is touched by God we do not have the ability to absorb it – to take it in.

### Psalm 139:17-18

How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! 18 If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand;

"That (while we were still sinners), Christ died for us."

### The fact that the Bible tells us that in eternity past

(in the mind of God, God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit)

"Christ died for us" is beyond our human scope.

If you are a lover of the Lord Jesus Christ, a follower of His, There is no longer a judgment, a penalty, a punishment that is looming over our heads, our lives!

# You will never hear the words "GET OUT" from the mouth of Jesus Christ if you're His child today.

### John 6:37

All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out. It's not that Jesus died for us 2000 years ago - it goes way beyond that to "why" = reconciliation, redemption & salvation it was God's eternal plan.

### Ephesians 1:3-5

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, 4 just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, 5 having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will.

### 1 John 4:9-11

In this the love of God was manifested toward us - that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. 10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood,

This "Much More" is a Powerful call to Consideration & Action. It is not that we shall be saved as in salvation. That has already been settled.

Romans Chapter 5 is affectionately known as the Chapter that Keeps on Giving "Much More" and for good reason. It is in This "Much More" that we learn that...

#### Romans 5:10

For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

#### Romans 5:15

But not as the offence, so also is the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.

#### Romans 5:17

For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)

### Romans 5:20

Moreover, the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:

### Justified grk: dikaioo

to bring forth in or to show to be righteous, to declare righteous: (an acknowledged justice)

Jesus' Death and Resurrection = Our Justification from Sin =
Us Being Forgiven =
= Us being Exempt from the Wrath, Anger, Indignation of God
that is Coming

# 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

# This "Wrath" is Regarding all that "Wrath" implies. The Wrath of God Against all That is Evil.

At present – God's grace is (1) Keeping a leash on evil in the world.

(2) But the wrath of God is upon this world (3) The wrath of God is still yet coming upon this world. (4) The wrath of God will be experienced by this Christ rejecting world in graphic ways for a 7-year long period of time coming called "The Tribulation."
