This new section of the book of Romans now continues building upon what was started in chapter 5, And that is – what’s the most important earthly thing, this side of heaven in all of Christianity and it is...

The Doctrine of Sanctification

which is, the divine work of God within a believer’s life through the Holy Spirit using the Word of God to Reproduce Jesus Christ in you – on earth!

1 Thessalonians 5:23-24

Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it.

Romans Chapter 5 argued for
our practical sanctification.

which is our daily living of life - on a day-to-day basis as a believer - powered
by the Word of God

(this is an observable reality - what you say you believe is backed up by how you live)

Romans chapter 6 argued for
our positional sanctification
which is the eternal fact - that our righteousness has been imputed to us, or
gifted to us based on Jesus Christ's work at the cross.
(this too is observable - what you say you believe is backed up by why you live)

Sanctify grk: hagiazo
to declare and to make holy, to consecrate, to take out of and to
place into, to dedicate and to keep.

Jude 1:24

Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to present you faultless before the
presence of His glory with exceeding joy, 25 To God our Savior, Who alone is wise, be glory
and majesty, dominion and power, both now and forever. Amen.

We now come to Romans chapter 7 which has often been referred to as "the neglected
chapter" because of its blunt honesty and its brutal depiction of the believer's struggle.

Dr. J Vernon McGee says;

"I was taught in Bible school that 'From Romans chapter 6 you ought to just take a
detour and drive around Romans 7 so you can hurry on over to chapter 8.'"

**But We Need Romans 7 to Encourage Us or You who need to
understand better – The Love of Him who gave it all.**

To know that while we are still here on earth we will struggle with the atmosphere of sin,
but there is a homecoming soon that will take us to where we really are.

Romans 7:1-6

Or do you not know, brethren (for I speak to those who know the law), that the law has
dominion over a man as long as he lives? 2 For the woman who has a husband is bound by the
law to her husband as long as he lives. But if the husband dies, she is released from the law of

her husband. 3 So then if, while her husband lives, she marries another man, she will be called an adulteress; but if her husband dies, she is free from that law, so that she is no adulteress, though she has married another man. 4 Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another – to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God. 5 For when we were in the flesh, the sinful passions which were aroused by the law were at work in our members to bear fruit to death. 6 But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter.

“One thing is certain regarding this passage; it is the legal maxim that is in focus here – and that is that death cancels all contracts.”

1a.) A living faith brings an end to a dead belief

vs. 1

Verse 1

1 Or do you not know, brethren (for I speak to those who know the law), that the law has dominion over a man as long as he lives?

dominion grk: kurieuo

legal jurisdiction, mastery, control, authority.

Paul here addresses his Jewish brother-in-law who had come to Christ, but struggled with the demands of the law. The Law dominates over the Jewish mind (any mind) when the Law is understood correctly.

“Our old nature, known as the Adamic nature, is under the authority of the **Law of God** because of sin. Our sin nature must answer to the **Law of God** because the Law is what accuses us of our actions.”

It is Truly Awesome to realize that even before God gave the law to Moses there was already a witness of his law in the heart of man (there was no 10 commandments in the garden of Eden, yet Adam and Eve knew that they had sinned.)

In his earlier days as a religious Jew and Pharisee,

Paul had a **wrong type of belief** placed in **the wrong type of person (himself)** which led him to a **fatal type of faith** that ended in death.

James 2:10-12

For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all. 11 For He who said, "Do not commit adultery," also said, "Do not murder." Now if you do not commit adultery, but you do murder, you have become a transgressor of the law. 12 So speak and so do as those who will be judged by the law of liberty.

Getting Free From A Fatal Relationship

When you believe that your relationship is completely based upon your good will, your faithfulness, your effort and your goodness – you have a fatal faith.

Galatians 2:16

knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified.

"But I Thought the Law was good? – It's Perfection (without a Heart)

1 Timothy 1:8-10

But we know that the law is good if one uses it lawfully, 9 knowing this: that the law is not made for a righteous person, but for the lawless and insubordinate, for the ungodly and for sinners, for the unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers, 10 for fornicators, for sodomites, for kidnappers, for liars, for perjurers, and if there is any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine,

But the authority of the Law is a poor motivator.

Known to all people is the fact that Love is the greatest motivator.

John 21:15-17

So when they had eaten breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me more than these?" He said to Him, "*Yes, Lord; You know that I love You.*" He said to him, "Feed ^(love) My lambs." 16 He said to him again a second time, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?" He said to Him, "*Yes, Lord; You know that I love You.*" He said to him, "Tend ^(care) My sheep." 17 He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?" For we are the circumcision, who worship God in the Spirit, rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh, 4 though I also might have confidence in the flesh. If anyone else thinks he may have confidence in the flesh, I more so: 5 circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of the Hebrews; concerning the law, a Pharisee; 6 concerning zeal, persecuting the church; concerning the righteousness which is in the law, blameless. 7 But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. 8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ 9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith; 10 that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death,

Stephan Preached of the First Sermons in The N.T.

Acts 7:51-53

“You stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You always resist the Holy Spirit; as your fathers did, so do you. 52 Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who foretold the coming of the Just One, of whom you now have become the betrayers and murderers, 53 who have received the law by the direction of angels and have not kept it.”

And Peter Echoed the Same in Acts

Acts 15:10

Now therefore, why do you test God by putting a yoke on the neck of the disciples which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?

vs. 2-3

Verse 2a

2a For the woman who has a husband is bound by the law to her husband as long as he lives.

{ Illustration }

It would do us well to see what we can about who is Paul speaking of.

The woman is referring to you and me - the church
The first husband may refer to either Adam or the Law
The second husband is without a doubt Jesus Christ

Paul is basically saying, "let me use the example of marriage which is the most binding issue that anyone can imagine. "

When Adam died (sinned) – we died (sinned) in Adam

William Carey - the father of modern missions was sent as a Missionary to Calcutta India in 1793, His social work extended beyond education to urge the government to outlaw such practices as infanticide and suttee (in which Hindu widows incinerate themselves on their husbands' funeral pyre). He also encouraged the use of Indians as missionaries and led in the formation of the Agricultural Society of India in 1820.

"We were once married to sin, but sin and its authority died at the cross of Christ – with sin being dead, we were set free to marry a second time – To Him who was God through Christ Jesus !

Verse 2b

2b But if the husband dies, she is released from the law of her husband.

The Goodness of God's Law

Is that it is the perfect moral statement and will remain unsurpassed in ethics. The Ten Commandments are The Greatest Guidepost and Guardrail in all of Human History.

But remember the law was given to show us how holy and righteous God is and how unholy and unrighteous we are.

Matthew 5:20-21,27-28

For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven. 21 "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder, and whoever murders will be in danger of the judgment.' 27 "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not commit adultery.' 28 But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.
