THE TITLE OF THE MESSAGE:

FREE SPEECH – PART 2

The Gospel of Grace. The Foundation of New Testament Theology
And How The Justified Shall Live by Faith in Jesus Christ Alone.

SUBJECT TOPICALLY REFERENCED UNDER:

Foreknowledge, Adoption, Sovereignty, Justification, Predestination, Election

Romans 10:5-13

For Moses writes about the righteousness which is of the law, *“The man who does those things shall live by them.”* **6** But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, *“Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’ ”* (that is, to bring Christ down from above) **7** or, *“ ‘Who will descend into the abyss?’ ”* (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).

8 But what does it say? *“The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart”* (that is, the word of faith which we preach): **9** that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. **10** For (1) with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and (2) with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

11 For the Scripture says, *“Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.”* **12** For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. **13** For *“whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.”*

It seems as though; I’m reminded every day – as I step out of the front door of the house, that there’s some package or box or envelope that was delivered in the night.

The evidence is irrefutable. I can see it! The evidence is tangible – I can touch it!
The experience is a Reality – I can hold, use it, & even talk about it right now!

The Lord would have to take on His word in the same way.

When Moses spoke – *He spoke the Word of God!*

When Samuel spoke – *He spoke the Word of God!*

When Isaiah spoke – *He spoke the Word of God!*

When Jeremiah spoke – *He spoke the Word of God!*

When God spoke – *He spoke the WORD!*

And when Jesus Christ speaks – *He is the WORD of God Speaking!*

John 1:1-2,14a

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **2**
He was in the beginning with God, **:14a** And the Word
became flesh and dwelt among us,

flesh

grk: sarx

bodily, physically and a tangible state, to be earthly or of this physical world, to be the place communing with personality.

Jesus Christ is God's Final Word...

Hebrews 1:1-2a

God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, 2 has in these last days spoken to us by His Son,

Christ is the Inspired Word...

2 Timothy 3:16-17

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Jesus Christ is the Authoritative Word...

2 Peter 1:16-21

For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty. 17

For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: “This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” 18 And we heard this voice which came from heaven when we were with Him on the holy mountain. 19 And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts; 20 knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, 21 for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

He is the Living Word...

Hebrews 4:12-13

For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

And He is the Only Word...

Acts 8:4-5

Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere preaching the word. 5 Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria and preached Christ to them.

Jesus Christ is The Empowered Word...

Acts 4:31

And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

The Power of God’s Word is a Transcendent & Supernatural
It is today - the greatest power on earth.

Jesus Christ, The Word of God is Our Commissioning Word...

Matthew 28:18-20

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age.” Amen.

Acts 1:8-11

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” **9** Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud (not cloudy) received Him out of their sight. **10** And while they looked (looked on) steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, **11** who also said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up (gawking) into heaven? This *same* Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come again in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.”

“What are you standing around for?

You heard what Jesus said - you’re on the clock now – So get up, get going & Get out of here, Ya got a lot to do”

Because Jesus Christ is the Unstoppable Word...

2 Timothy 2:9c

The Word of God is not chained.

Chained grk: deo
unable be to tie down or tied up, cannot be bound, or imprisoned. Cannot be made to be static.

John 7:37-39a

On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. **38** He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” **39** But this He spoke concerning the Holy Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive.

FREE SPEECH IS THE GREAT REALITY

2c.) Let The Truth Be Known

vs. 10

We come to what I call here -
The Symbiosis or Symbiotics' of the Salvation Doctrine.
That is that, these two truths are in inseparable agreement or symbiosis.

Verse 10

10 For (1) with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and
(2) with the mouth (one) confession is made unto salvation.

For (1) with the heart one believes unto righteousness

This is to believe that #1 Jesus Christ died on the cross for your sins and #2 is to believe that by His resurrection from the dead, you are now declared justified by God in Christ.

and (2) with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Galatians 2:20-21

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. **21** I do not set aside the grace of God; for if righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died in vain."

FREE SPEECH

3.) Is The Great Redeemer

vs. 11-13

FREE SPEECH IS THE GREAT REDEEMER

3a.) When Redemption is Available

vs. 11

For the Scripture says,
"Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."

His Redemption **for us & of us** - - Removes Shame !!

Shame grk: kataischuno
disappointment or being disgraced, you will not be humiliated
or embarrassed.

Regarding The Wicked. The Bible Says...

Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion. Let them be clothed with **shame** and dishonored - those who exalt themselves against Me.

2 Timothy 1:12b

I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day.

Romans 8:33

Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies.

Isaiah 6:7

And he touched my mouth with it, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged."

Verse 12a

For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek,

Colossians 3:11

There is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave nor free, but Christ is all and in all.

Galatians 3:28

There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

Distinction grk: dia'sto'le
no dissection, no void or gulf, no separation,
no difference in oneness.

Regarding Those Who Teach the Heresy of Replacement Theology,

that is – the gentile is the Jew, and the Jew is no more. That the church now is somehow Israel and Israel is no more. - with the conclusion that there is no longer a historical Israel or a historical Jew, This belief calls God a liar and that He’s too weak to keep His promises.

The Bible doesn’t deny the existence of gentiles or Jews.
the doctrine of the Bible is, in Christ Jesus - they are united as one in Spirit.

FREE SPEECH IS THE GREAT REDEEMER

3b.) When Redemption is Received

vs. 12

Verse 12b

for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him.

The word “Same” means “The Absolute Same”,
“The Unchanging Same”. “The Same – Same”

Malachi 3:6a

“For I am the LORD, I do not change.

Numbers 23:19

“God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?”

Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Lord

grk: ku’ri’os

sir, master, owner – this title of Jesus Christ was the most descriptive of His early existence because this title included all those that have authority from a house manager to Caesar himself. – The “Jesus is Lord” trumped all others.

Rich

grk: plou’te’o

abounding in riches, to become rich, to become wealthy,
to get riches, to make rich.

I FIND THIS ABSOLUTELY AWESOME

His “Revelation of Himself” It has Always Been Fascinating to Me.
Note with me PLEASE – That the Prerequisite, The First Requirement
from The Almighty God is that we might **“Call Upon Him”**
Which means that **He is waiting – waiting – waiting to hear from you.**

Psalm 145:18-19

The LORD is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him in truth. **19** He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear their cry and save them.

Isaiah 45:21b-22

There is no other God besides Me, a just God and a Savior; there is none besides Me.
22 “Look to Me, and be saved, all you ends of the earth!
For I am God, and there is no other.

Jeremiah 33:3

“Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great
and mighty things, which you do not know.’

“That’s 1-800-Jeremiah 33:3 call today” - - but wait, there’s more.

HAVE YOU PLACED THE CALL ?

Malachi 3:16

Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another,
And the LORD listened and heard them;
So a book of remembrance was written before Him
For those who fear the LORD and who meditate on His name.

3c.) When Redemption is Yours

vs. 13

13 For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.”

Joel 2:32

And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the LORD Shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, As the LORD has said, among the remnant whom the LORD calls

- Calls** grk: epi'ka'leo
to address your appeal toward heaven, to make an appeal. (heb: qara – to cry out, to shout out, to speak out, to speak about, to talk about – to be consumed by or in a state of obsession)
- Name** grk: o'no'ma
the word; the name, the authority, The Absolute One
The Famous One, The One
- LORD** grk: ku'ri'os
sir, master, owner – this title of Jesus Christ was the most descriptive of His early existence - The Name. heb: YHVH / YHWH
Yehovah or Yahveh) The personal & proper Name of the God of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob – Israel. – Can You Name Your God
- Delivered / Saved** grk: so'zo / heb ma'lat
to rescue, to bring to safety, to cure, make well, preserve,
recover, to reclaim, restore. Heb: ma'lat: to give birth to, to pull out or to snatch away, to escape, to get up and away, to leap forth.

Acts 13:48

Now when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and glorified the word of the Lord. And as many as had been appointed (tas'so) to eternal life believed.

- Appointed** grk: tasso
to draw up in order, to arrange, to designate, devote, established,
to set you in your place or to be seated at the table reserved for you.
