But what do we mean by “The Perfect Gospel?”
It is the Good News that God has revealed to us in the Bible.

This world is condemned and has been under God’s curse since the day Adam and Eve sinned. And this world that we live in now - is an absolute misfit-failure, compared to the perfect world of God. In that perfect world that once was – mankind was to live with God, with Him forever in absolute harmony. But sin thwarted all of that and continues to do so in the lives of all those who do not believe. For those of us who do believe, the Gospel of God is the message of salvation, and it is a guaranteed salvation both now and forever.

Romans 15:8-13

8 Now I say that Jesus Christ has become a servant to the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises *made* to the fathers, **9** and that the Gentiles might glorify God for *His* mercy, as it is written: *“For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, and sing to Your name.”* **10** And again He says: *“Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people!”* **11** And again: *“Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles! Laud Him, all you peoples!”* **12** And again, Isaiah says: *“There shall be a root of Jesse; and He who shall rise to reign over the Gentiles, In Him the Gentiles shall hope.”* **13** Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

1a.) Jesus was made flesh - so as to come to us

vs. 8a

8a Now I say that Jesus Christ has become a servant
to the circumcision for the truth of God,

This is The Incarnation of The Eternal Son of God.

Ephesians 2:4-9

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, **5** even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), **6** and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, **7** that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. **8** For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, **9** not of works, lest anyone should boast.

“To The Circumcision” that is, The Jews.

John 4:22-23

You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, *for salvation is of the Jews.* **23** But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

Verse 8a

...For the truth of God !!!

(i.e.) For the keeping of God’s word. For the Scriptural integrity of the Bible is Proven by Biblical Prophecy.

1b.) Jesus was commissioned - so as to fulfill prophecy

vs. 8b

8b to confirm the promises made to the fathers,

These eight (8) words make up the answer to The Question,
What is Biblical Prophecy?

It is the confirmation of the promises made to the fathers.

The ability of the Bible to predict the future in advance is unlike any other religious writings throughout all of human history. It is not only that other books do not come close to being like the Bible, it is that there is nothing even remotely close to being like the Bible.

Ephesians 2:11-13 NLT

Don't forget that you Gentiles used to be outsiders. You were called "uncircumcised heathens" by the Jews, who were proud of their circumcision, even though it affected only their bodies and not their hearts. 12 In those days you were living apart from Christ. You were excluded from citizenship among the people of Israel, and you did not know the covenant promises God had made to them. You lived in this world without God and without hope. 13 But now you have been united with Christ Jesus. Once you were far away from God, but now you have been brought near to him through the blood of Christ.

Galatians 3:13-14,16

Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), **14** that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith, **16** Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Christ.

grk: be'ba'i'oo

to make secure or to confirm an oath, to establish or erect that which was voiced or spoken.

Verse 8b

8b to confirm the promises **Made To The Fathers,**

2 Peter 1:19a

2 Peter 1:19-21

And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts; **20** knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, **21** for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

2 Timothy 4:1-5

Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. **3** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, *because* they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; **4** and they will turn *their* ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. **5** But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

Promises

grk: epaggelia

to say in advance, to speak ahead of what is to come, to invite one’s trust and faith to be placed in what has been said about what is to come.

Hebrews 1:1-3

1c.) Jesus was made to be our peace and salvation vs. 9a

Verse 9a

9a and that the Gentiles might glorify God for His MERCY,

God Made Covenantal Promises to Israel.

&

God Has Extended Mercy to the Nation.

Ephesians 2:11-16

Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh - who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands - **12** that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. **13** But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. **14** For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, **15** having abolished in His flesh the enmity, *that is*, the law of commandments *contained* in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man *from* the two, *thus* making peace, **16** and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.

Romans 11:1-21

I say then, has God cast away His people? Certainly not! For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. **2** God has not cast away His people whom He foreknew. Or do you not know what the Scripture says of Elijah, how he pleads with God against Israel, saying, **3** "LORD, they have killed Your prophets and torn down Your altars, and I alone am left, and they seek my life"? **4** But what does the divine response say to him? "*I have reserved for Myself seven thousand men who have not bowed the knee to Baal.*" **5** Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election of grace. **6** And if by grace, then *it is* no longer of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if *it is* of works, it is no longer grace; otherwise work is no longer work. **7** What then? Israel has not obtained what it seeks; but the elect have obtained it, and the rest were blinded. **8** Just as it is written: "*God has given them a spirit of stupor, Eyes that they should not see And ears that they should not hear, To this very day.*" **9** And David says: "*Let their table become a snare and a trap, A stumbling block and a recompense to them.*" **10** *Let their eyes be darkened, so that they do not see, And bow down their back always.*" **11** I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation *has come* to the Gentiles. **12** Now if their fall *is* riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness! **13** For I speak to you Gentiles; inasmuch as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry, **14** if by any means I may provoke to jealousy *those who are* my flesh and save some of them. **15** For if their being cast away *is* the reconciling of the world, what *will* their acceptance *be* but life from the dead? **16** For if the firstfruit *is* holy, the lump *is* also *holy*; and if the root *is* holy, so *are* the branches. **17** And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, **18** do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, *remember that* you do not support the root, but the root supports you. **19** You will say then, "Branches were broken off that I might be grafted in." **20** Well *said*. Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear. **21** For if God did not spare the natural branches, He may not spare you either.

Isaiah 43:11-12

I, *even I, am* the LORD, and besides Me *there is* no savior.

12 I have declared and saved, I have proclaimed, And *there was* no foreign god among you; Therefore you *are* My witnesses," says the LORD, "that I *am* God.

2a.) Results in Praise

vs. 9b

Verse 9b

as it is written:

*“For this reason I will confess to You
among the Gentiles, and sing to Your name.”*

AS IT IS WRITTEN “Among The Gentiles”

John 10:11-16

“I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep. **12** But a hireling, *he who is* not the shepherd, one who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees; and the wolf catches the sheep and scatters them. **13** The hireling flees because he is a hireling and does not care about the sheep. **14** I am the good shepherd; and I know My *sheep*, and am known by My own. **15** As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. **16** And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock *and* one shepherd.

Galatians 3:26-29

For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. **27** For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. **28** There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. **29** And if you *are* Christ’s, then you are Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Confess grk: ex’o’mo’lo’ge’o
to agree, to say the same thing, to be in concert with, to give full consent.

Sing grk: ps’al’lo
to pull upon, to pluck or to play – the song of the heart, to express the joy and effect from the soul. to make melody, sing praises.

Quoting The Old Testament

2 Samuael 22:50 & Psalm 18:49

Therefore, I will give thanks to You, O LORD, among the Gentiles,
and sing praises to Your name.

2b.) Results in Joy

vs. 10

Verse 10

10 And again He says:
“Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people

Rejoice grk: Eu'phrain'o
to cheer, to make merry, glad living, a life of joy-ing.

Kenneth Wuest

Eu'phrain'o comes from the root word “phrain'o,” meaning “to be sober-minded” or “to be of sound mind.” The addition of the prefix “eu-” adds an element of goodness or pleasantness. Together, these elements convey a picture of joyful clarity, possessing a state of gladness that is both uplifting and constructive and resilient to outside influences.”

2c.) Results in Expression

vs. 11

Verse 11

11 And again: *“Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles!
Laud Him, all you peoples!”*

Laud grk: epaineo
the full expression of praise and glory. to shout, proclaim, announce, herald forth with a strong voice. (the heavenly host of all those before the face of God, both man and angel alike in unison)

Enthusiasm

applied to the effect upon one's life of worship of the Divine. The animation that springs forth from the worship of a god or gods which results in an active expression worthy of the object or person or deity.
