The Living Parable before them

"Judas the Zealot of Galilee"

Acts 5:37-39 KJV

After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and all, even as many as obeyed him,

Verse 43-48

2 Corinthians 13:5 KJV

Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

Examine: GRK; peirazo (pi-rad'-zo)

scrutinize, to assay as metal **(To give the acid test)** go about, prove.

(Search) • Is my walk worthy of Christ Jesus

(Evaluate) • Am I doing anything to stumble others

(Destroy) • What do I do to insure my effectiveness

Psalm 139:23-24 KJV

Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: ²⁴ And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Psalm 26:2 KJV

Examine me, O LORD, and prove me; try my reins and my heart.

(III) Our *Position* in Ministry at the End ver. 49-50

Verse 49-50

The truth of the matter is that each one of us here, has an appointment with the altar of sacrifice

Leviticus 2:13 KJV

with all thine offerings thou shalt offer salt.

(KNOWN AS THE SALT OF THE COVENANT)

The salt was to represent preservation, cleansing, healing

To The Greek mind

The source of salt the sun and the sea, was the two most pure things known

It does seem right that hell should be forever (Listen, when you sin, you sin against The Holy God of The Universe and you forfeited your rights!!!!)

The soul that sins, it shall surely die

Romans 3:23

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

The Truth is... you need Jesus

Rembrandt has a picture of Christ being crucified, as Jesus is looking at his hand being prepared to receive the nails the arm of Rembrandt is reaching in to drive the nails himself.

Isaiah 28:15a

Because ye have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with hell are we in agreement;

Verse 50

We are to be a preserving factor in the world....

Our lives should smart the **eye's** of the of the world, the **hands** that are sinning should burn and the **feet** should leap away from the results of sin

Matthew 8:12 KJV

But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into *outer darkness*: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
