INTRODUCTION; The sacrifice of the King

John Wesley's story and his conversion to Christ.

Born 1703, a missionary to the American Indians and Prof. of Greek & Logic and Biblical studies in England.

It wasn't until at the age of 35 that Wesley opened his Bible to Mark 12:34 - "You are not far from the Kingdom"

... And yielded his life to Jesus of Nazareth.

The Lamb's Examination;

Chpt.11:27&28 *chief priest, scribes* & *elders* came challenging him "by what authority"

12:12	<i>They</i> sought to lay hands on him
12:13	Then <u>they</u> sent to Him some Pharisees
12:18	Then <i>some</i> Sadducees

RELIGIOUS, BUT MISSING THE MARK (SIN)

Recently We Visited the Grand Canyon

rising early, before daybreak, 35°, camera in hand I waited for an hour for the right picture....

Suddenly

I missed it	

WELL,

- The Scribe will Focus on keeping the Commandments
- Jesus will rightly interpret the Commandments
- And make the priority "Love", and "Heaven" the goal

A.) Questioning

the Kingdom vv. 28

Matthew's account 22:34-35

After silencing the Sadducees, the Pharisees huddled, Then one came from them, to Jesus "testing" Him

<u>Testing</u> GRK peirazo (pi-rad'-zo);

to endeavor, scrutinize, entice, to walk about examining, to prove,

A "Matter" of the Heart;

PerceivingGRK to become aware, to have insightAnsweredGRK to CONTRADICT with truth

He understood the response to be Theologically correct

Verse 28

"which is the greatest commandment of all"

(An often debated issue among the Legalist)

He was impressed with the intellect, the character, the morality of Jesus and was drawn to him.

John 6:44a

"No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him;

B.) The Life of the Kingdom vv. 29-31

Verse 29

THE FIRST;

Quoting **Deut. 6:4** (the SHEMA Israel)

which was recited by every serious Jew morning and evening and housed in the *phylactery*.

As Christians we believe that God is one, revealed in scripture in three personalities

We are monotheistic, we believe in one God, who is Creator of all and Lord overall and Savior of all

For there are *three* that bear witness in heaven: the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are *one*.

CREATOR

Gen 1:1

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

John 1:1-3

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² The same was in the beginning with God ³ All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

SAVIOR

Isaiah 45:21 KJV

who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? *there is no God beside me*; a just God and a **Saviour**; *there is none beside me*.

SECOND;

- •The love of man CONFESSED.

He who loves God supremely will honor God in everything. He who loves God supremely will honor man in everything.

A Premium on God-given Life

Romans 13:8 KJV

Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law.

By Jesus Fusing these two scriptures together, He brought Faith down, out of the clouds and on to the streets.

It was a commentary on the Big 10 making it the necessary 2

Consolidating the first 4 (God ward) and the last 6 (man ward)

Galatians 5:14

For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

C.) *Nearing* the Kingdom

vv. 32-34

The very witness of Jesus, His "ethos" His style, was loving God & loving man
No man could deny

By answering well, the scribe showed that he was able & willing to think for himself, that *he was intellectually honest - it made sense*

Our modern-day Logic is so shallow,

•We think nothing through, • We reason nothing out

• Just live for the moment!!!

Verse 32,33

(#1)

He is nearing the Kingdom, because he is realizing that keeping the law, the commandments, is nothing more then external duties performed *(prayer mtg. committees, bible studies, worship min. Ushers min.)* - is external, religious nothingness.

(#2)

Being intelligent, being well educated does not mean you have the truth

Verse 33b.

homologeo (hom-ol-og-eh'-o)

Romans 10:9

that if you *confess* with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead you will be saved.

... You are not far from the Kingdom (from the Reign)

A warning that we can be near or far

Are you in?

Do you know?, are you sure? on what grounds?

Ephesians 2:8-10a

For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not of works, lest anyone should boast. ¹⁰ For we are His workmanship (Stop self-help)

WHAT MAKES SENSE TO YOU?

Is it Humanism, Evolution, New Age Game

A WARNING is also meant here;

Near, but not in,

There are many good people, but good people do not go to heaven;

Romans 7:9-11

For I was alive without the law once (I was good): but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died. ¹⁰ And the commandment, which was to bring life, I found to bring death. ¹¹ For sin, seizing the moment, by the commandment, deceived me, and by it killed me.

Galatians 2:16

Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ,... ...not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

Romans 3:21-23

But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, ²² even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference; ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all.

Galatians 3:22-24

But the Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe. ²³ But before faith came, we were *kept under guard* by the law, kept for the faith which would afterward be revealed. ²⁴ Therefore the law was our *tutor* (*paidagogos*, *one you disciplines*, *shows fault*, *error* & *failure*) our to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

Verse 34

You're NOT far, But still not in.

The way you are thinking, you're not far from the kingdom" Serious Thoughts;

1. It's possible to have been born into a churched family and not know Christ

- 3. It is possible to think you're going to heaven because you have been "good"
- 4. You may be religious, "tidy-bowl Christian" look good, smell good, but in the end, they go down the drain.
