Hebrews 1:5

to which of the angels did He ever say: "You are My Son, today I have begotten You"? And again: "I will be to Him a Father, and He shall be to Me a Son"?

Psalm 2:7

"I will declare the decree: the LORD has said to Me, 'You are My Son, today I have begotten You.

They saw nothing of the supernatural - They had a small view of God and of scripture...

...which produces weak Ideals, small hearts & limited vision.

(THEY WERE NEAR-SIGHTED)

Verse 36

Jesus here supporting the Inspiration of scripture...

" By the Holy Spirit "

Quoting Psalm 110:1

Quoting Psalm 110:1

The well known Messianic psalm

(The point he is trying to make is that the God of David was also the descendant of David, who would be the savior of the world)

Your enemies your foot stool...

The Hebrew paints the picture of a conquering general with His foot on the neck of His enemy.

Hebrew

the LORD (*Jehovah*) said unto my LORD (*Adonai*)

ENG. LORD JESUS CHRIST

GRK. KURIOS IESOUS CHRISTOS

HEB. ADONAI ' YAH ' SHUA HA ' MAY ' SHE ' ACH

If David calls Him;

- YAHWEH, lord *Jehovah*, *Eternal one*
- YAHWEH, lord *Adonai*, *Master, king*

How on earth can the Jehovah, Adonai be David's son
- Yet that's what the scriptures say - don't they!

... THEY WERE (*and are* NEAR-SIGHTED)

Verse 37a

IF HE'S DAVID'S BOY, THEN WHY WOULD DAVID CALL HIM LORD,
GREATER THAN THE FATHER.

IT'S POSSIBLE TO KNOW... *WHOSE SON*
IS
THE CHRIST
(*That's why the question was asked*)

The crowd was joyous over the frustration of the Scribes & Pharisees and encouraged in their theology.

a sweet taste, a pleasant thing

The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes; ...**sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.**

B.) Jesus' teaching *About Others* Verses 38-40

In Matthew's parallel account, the Famous 7 woes of Christ are delivered at this point

Verse 38

He turns now to the people and instructed them

The scribes and their flowing power-dress sickened Jesus

Elongated robes, evange-lastically, exaggerated robes, like clowns

Matthew 23:5

"But all their works they do to be seen by men. They make their phylacteries broad and enlarge the borders of their garments.

Disfigure their faces (Ashes & onions)

Verse 40

Devour to fatten or make full, EXTORTION
Pretense, to cover up by show,

by the blowing of horns, tooting

I.) Jesus warns against preeminence;

Those who desire to do "Christian Things" to be noticed or promoted, rather than selfless servitude to God's people

Matthew 6:3

"But when you do a charitable deed, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing,

II.) Jesus warns against reverence;

Psalms 89:7

God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be held in reverence by all those around Him.

Matthew 23:9 KJV

And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.

III.) Jesus warns against "professionalism" religion;

There are those who seek advancement in the ministry, I'll do this to broaden my base, my position, I'll write this book to get my name out there.- *Enlarge the boarder of my garment*

God might want your book out there, your music out there, your name out there but not for your own glory & gain
