The Trials in Life Naturally cause us to want to Know Why

The Word of God Brings the needed Knowledge But it is Wisdom that appropriates the knowledge

Wisdom is the Proper Use of Knowledge

You can be a Nobel Prize winning Rocket Scientist and yet possess very little or no wisdom at all

Knowledge can be Acquired -- But Wisdom is Received

"We will not always have knowledge of what to do in the middle of a trial but we can have the wisdom of God to see us through it"

When knowledge is scarce - faith provides what we need

We are Developed under the pressure of Trials

Know the Full story

John 16:33b ...In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."
