INTRODUCTION: The Reading of The Text vv. 14-20

Summation of The Text

Throughout History, Judeo-Christianity has done more to better the world than any other faith in Human history! All one needs to do is look to the great centers of education around the world. Look to the Humanitarian efforts around the world, hospitals, relief operations and standard and quality of living and life.

A careful and accurate study in Sociology clearly shows that wherever Christianity has gone throughout the ages, the morality and value for human life and creation has become the norm in those cultures.

Why?

Because Christianity is a Faith that Does It's Practical and Usable and the World is Enjoying its Blessings

> "True Faith in God, Produces Great Works Among Men"

On a Theological Level,

We have to ask if Christianity is justified by what it says, or by what it does?

Great Controversy Surrounds this section of James

Martin Luther the great reformer

Struggled with the Book of James because he considered it a contradiction to the Apostle Paul's Arguments that a man is justified by Faith alone and not by any works of righteousness!

People, Churches Argue Today About this Very Thing

James is not attacking salvation by faith alone

James is attacking a "False Profession of Faith" saying that if you believe in the Bible, in God and in His Christ and turn away and actually do nothing with your so-called-faith, called Christianity, then you're not a Christian!

Consider James' Audience:

Predominantly Jewish in background, others certainly Gentile but all converted to Christ - born again believers

James' Argument is with those who "Said" they were Christians but "Did" nothing with their Christianity

James 2:24 KJV

Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only.

Jesus Warned Against the Same

Mark 4:16-17

"These likewise are the ones sown on stony ground who, when they hear the word, immediately receive it with gladness; ¹⁷ and they have no root in themselves, and so endure only for awhile.

Frankly,

People who say they're Christians and live contrary to the Christian life make my job hard... and yours

In 1996 - George Barna Poll

25% of Americans Claimed to be Christians, 65 million people Nationwide (I seriously doubt that statistic)

Honestly,

Christianity has a black eye among many people of the world because of professors of righteousness and not doers!

The *Relationship* Between Faith and Works

The First Person Ever Made Righteous ((and The Rule of First Mention))

Genesis 15:5-6

Then the Lord brought Abraham outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." 6 **And Abraham believed in the LORD**, and the Lord (accounted) it to him for **righteousness**.

In a Supernatural, Divine Moment

God "Justified" Abraham when Abraham Believed in the Lord

But what does "Believe" really mean?

A Difference Exists between James' word for 'works' and Paul's word for 'works' by the context of how it is used

Romans 3:27-28

Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? No, but by **the law of faith**. ²⁸ Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith apart from **the works of the law**.

Paul's "Works"

is referring to the Old Testament, the Law, the Morality, the Dietary laws

James' "Works"

is referring to the New testament, lifestyle, practices, fruitful living

Do Not Confuse the "Works" in Paul's Teaching

With the "Works" of James' teaching

It is the Same Greek Word.

* works ar

grk 2041 ergon (er'-gon);

to toil at a task or at employment. To exert pressure, to sweat at laboring

But in a totally Different Context

(And that's why cults peddle at your door)

Ephesians 2:8-9

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Paul's argument is:

you can't earn salvation by doing this

James' argument is:

now that you are saved, this is what you will do

1.) What We Say must Agree With What we Do

vv. 14

What does it **profit**, my brethren, if someone **says** he has faith but does not have **works**? Can faith **save** him?

1a.) What we say must **profit** how we live - profession

If someone says

* says

grk 3004 lego (leg'-o)

to "lay" forth the words. To proclaim something as a truth. To be saying, talking, telling others

Present Tense - is saying he has faith

To be one who has made a profession and is currently making the profession

if someone says

(it may be true, it may be false)

a Mere Profession of Faith - Not Active, Salvation Faith

No Real "Lifestyle" Change

14 What does it profit, my brethren,

* profit

grk 3786 ophelos (of'-el-os);

what advantage, what gain is there (to heap up, to accumulate or benefit)

Peter Issued a Warning About This:

2 Peter 2:19-22

While they promise them liberty, they themselves are slaves of corruption; for by whom a person is overcome, by him also he is brought into bondage. ²⁰ For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning. ²¹ For it would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered to them. ²² But it has happened to them according to the true proverb: "A dog returns to his own vomit," and, "a sow, having washed, to her wallowing in the mire."

We Personally, What Profit have we Experienced Since Naming Christ?

Our family, friends and enemies can tell us ???? HAS THERE BEEN A LASTING CHANGE ????

John 15:16b

"You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father

John 15:5

"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

1b.) There will be no works to prove their profession

If someone says he has faith but does not have works

There's no physical evidence to the profession of being a Christian

Are you doing Christian things or just saying you're a Christian?

168 hours have passed since last week How many of those hours were dedicated to God in your life?

But I went Forward at The Billy Graham Crusade (That's great for Billy Graham - but did you change?)

I John 1:6-7

If we say that we have fellowship with Him (God), and walk (lifestyle) in darkness, (sin) we lie and do not practice the truth. 7 But if we walk in the light (right living) as He is in the light,

#1 - we have fellowship with one another,
and #2 - the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Your Living Tells All - Not What You Say

I am **Not** talking about the Christian who is struggling with sin - temper, laziness or lust

1c.) Such Faith is No Faith at All - it Accomplishes Nothing

Can faith (this type) save him?

* save grk 4982 sozo (sode'-zo);

to heal from and to preserve from sin and it's judgment

No - Not this Kind of Faith - The Negative is here - No!

Such a person is lying to themselves and to others around him. He is in fact - not a Christian at all - just watch and you'll see

James 1:22

But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, **deceiving yourselves**.

And the word of God has just judged him not a Christian

This Person hasn't Lost their Salvation

They Never Had it to begin with

2.) How We Live in Practice Tells All

vv. 15-16

If a brother or sister is **naked** and **destitute** of daily food, **16** and one of you **says** to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not **give** them the things which are needed for the body, what does it **profit**?

James Inserts another Illustration

2a.) True Faith Serves its Brothers and Sisters

If a brother or sister

Our Fellowship within the Church

Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, but especially to those who are of **the household of faith**. - the church

2b.) When we Meet the Needs of the Local Body

If a brother or sister is **naked** and **destitute** of daily food

1 Timothy 6:8

And having food and clothing, with these we shall be content.

Having Compassion on the Brother or Sister in Need is a characteristic of Christ

True Faith will do Something About it

2c.) Our Response Reveals the Depth to Our Profession

And one of you **says** to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not **give** them the things which are needed for the body, what does it **profit**?

I see this "So-Called" Christian with a drum stick in his mouth, a bag of potato chips in one hand and pork ribs in the other, and Twinkies stuffed in every pocket... "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," - see ya at church next week... O' huhmmm remember to praise the Lord man

I John 3:16-17

By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. ¹⁷ But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him? -- IT DOESN'T!

SEVERAL WEEKS AGO A MAN CAME INTO MY OFFICE

and said, God has blessed my life. I want to bless others but also this too. I want to get all the other guy's in this church who've been blessed with money and meet with em'-form some kind of spiritual investment group to free up the money and have it working for His glory...

"Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," HERE'S A BASKET OF FOOD OR A SHIRT

"But you do not **give** them the things which are needed for the body, what does it **profit**?

When in fact you possess what they need, but withhold it from them

Ephesians 4:28

Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with his hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need.

Proverbs 19:17
He who has pity on the poor lends to the LORD, and He will pay back what he has given.

3.) Real Faith is as a Compass toward the Christian v. 17-20

Thus also faith (professed) by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

The *Responsibility* Between Faith and Works

They cannot contradict each other -- but only confirm one another

dead grk 3498 nekros (nek-ros');
a rotting corpse. A dead carcass

- 1.Professing faith works = death
- 2. Professing faith + works = death (works religion)
- 3. (Saving) faith produces + works = life

Real Faith is as a Compass toward the Christian 3a.) Only Works can Make my Faith Visible

18 But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works."

Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.

- You say "I have Faith" Big Deal
- I'll **Show** you my works which back up the fact that I have faith

You Cannot Prove that you have Faith without showing me your works

IT'S IMPOSSIBLE

You Cannot Back Up Your Faith By What You Say, Only by what you do!!!

It's Doesn't Matter
What You Say about Christ

WHO THEN IS A TRUE BELIEVER, FOR REAL?

Real Faith is as a Compass toward the Christian 3b.) Be careful to Make Sure that you Really Trust in Christ

You **believe** that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons **believe**-- and **tremble!**

* believe grk 4100 pisteuo (pist-yoo'-o);

to have faith (in, upon, or with respect to, a person or thing), i.e. credit

* tremble grk 5425 phrisso (fris'-so);

To "bristle" or chill, the skin of, to cause to shudder of fear. To make as Goose flesh

The Point is...

They Know A lot and They're Not Saved

Satan Can Say "I Believe in God" and mean it yet be totally lost

20 But do you want to know, **O foolish man**, that **faith** without **works** is **dead**?

To **Believe** is to Acknowledge Christ, To **Have** Faith is Trust in Him

20 But do you want to know, **O foolish man**,

"Do any of you really want to know the truth"

We should be concerned about those who say but do not obey

James is Warning Against Easy Believe-ism which is a cheap grace - a message that kills

foolish grk 2756 kenos (ken-os');
having an empty container or bucket

O You Empty (worksless) Man - Me/You

20 faith without works is dead!!! - Dead

not weak / not sick / not little

Matthew 13:24-30
