There was a Corporate Memorial of the Nation

4 Then Joshua called the twelve men whom he had appointed from the children of Israel, one man from every tribe; 5 and Joshua said to them: "Cross over before the ark of the LORD your God **into the midst of the Jordan, and each one of you take up a stone** on his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the children of Israel, - 12

Erected 8 Miles West of the Jordan River Crossing in Gilgal

Memorial(s)

2nd

There was the Personal Memorial of Joshua Himself

9 Then Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of the Jordan, in the place where the feet of the priests who bore the ark of the covenant **stood**; and they are there to this day. 10 So the priests who bore the ark **stood** in the midst of the Jordan until everything was finished that the LORD had commanded Joshua to speak to the people, according to all that Moses had commanded Joshua; and the people hurried and crossed over.

Erected 10-15 Feet Below the Jordan River at the Place of the Crossing

Privately, Joshua

Had Entered the Jor-Dan (the spreading = Judgement) on One side and Had Come Up Someone All together Different

Matthew 3:1-6

1 And In those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the Desert of Judea 2 and saying, "**Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near.**" 5 and the People went out to him from Jerusalem and all Judea and the whole region of the Jordan (river valley). 6 Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River.

Then John consented. 16 As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and lighting on him. 17 And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."

a) Demands Our Effort Because We're to be Crossing Over v.11

11 Then it came to pass, when all the people had **completely crossed over**, that the ark of the LORD and the priests crossed over in the presence of the people.

The Israeli People

(the recipients) of God's Goodness and Favor,
were tucked in the middle of the works of God

The Jewish Priest

(the representatives) of God's Goodness and favor
were the First to Go in, and they were Last to Go Out

Possessing God's Promises

Demands Our Effort Because We're to be Crossing Over

Like Naaman of Old in II-Kings 5

He had to Submerge His Leprous Body in the Jordan (7) Times according to Elisha
It took Faith, it took Effort

Verse 12-13

12 And the men of Reuben, the men of Gad, and half the tribe of Manasseh crossed over armed before the children of Israel, as Moses had spoken to them. 13 About forty thousand prepared for war **crossed over** before the LORD for battle, to the plains of Jericho.

These 2 1/2 tribes, According to Numbers Chapter 26
totaled an amount of 136,930 the men of war.

"About forty thousand"

That was 29% of the male-military population of these 2 1/2 tribes.

Possessing God's Promises

a) Requires Obedience To Those Whom God has Called v.14

14 On that day the LORD **exalted** Joshua in the sight of all Israel; and they **feared** him, as they had feared Moses, **all the days of his life**.

Exalted / Feared / All the days of his life

Hebrews 13:7

Remember those who **rule over you**, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of their conduct.

Hebrews 13:17

Obey those who **rule over you**, and be **submissive** for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you.

Hebrews 13:24

Greet all those who **rule over you**, and all the saints. Those from Italy greet you.

Jesus' Last Week on Earth is Well Documented

Passover Week

(Resurrection Sunday is always on a Full Moon)

Out of Egypt

The tenth day of the month of Nisan, four days before the 14th - Passover, -- was the very day when the lamb was required to be selected,

Exodus 12:1-5, 12-14

1 Now the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, 2 "This month shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you. 3 "Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: 'On the tenth day of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household. 4 'And if the household is too small for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next to his house take it according to the number of the persons; according to each man's need you shall make your count for the lamb. 5 'Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year.....

12 'For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.

13 'Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

14 'So this day shall be to you a memorial; and you shall keep it as a feast to the LORD throughout your generations. You shall keep it as a feast by an everlasting ordinance.

In the providence of God, He arranged that the entrance into the promised land should be 36 years.

What has become to be known as Palm Sunday fell

On April 6th, 32 ad.

Jesus was Declared KING to the Nation Israel

On Monday April 7th

Jesus Prophesied that Israel would reject Him.

On Tuesday April 8th.

Jesus Taught His longest Day of Teaching

On Wednesday April 9th.

Jesus continues to be beaten then crucified & dies & buried

On Sunday Morning April 14th.

The Garden Tomb is found Empty and Jesus Alive

The 14th was Four days after the 10th

On THIS The 10th. Day of the First Month

The Families of Children of Israel had to select a male lamb and take Him home and Examine Him for Perfection then sacrifice it for their sins

'These are the feasts of the LORD, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times. 5 'On the fourteenth day of the first month at twilight is the LORD'S Passover.

He was Arrested (selected) on April 10. He was Tried (Examined) and Sentenced (Judged) But On the 14th

The Nation was Freed from its Sin
