INTRODUCTION: Reviewing of Our Previous Message

Nimrod, the Babylonian believed that heaven could be captured and be brought down to earth as he would rule over it.

Adolf Hitler Believed that He could create a Paradise-Heaven on earth if the world would rid itself of the genetically impure, the handicapped, the retarded, and the Jewish race.

The Atheist and Communist Carl Marx believed that Heaven on earth could be established by creating a "common-world" where all men might live and enjoy all things shared.

Even today there is this false doctrine of Dominion Theology that believes that the church will eventually "Christianize" the world and usher in a Utopia on earth.

Hope is Built on Faith

Hebrews 11

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good testimony. 3 By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.......6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him..........29 By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned. 30 By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they were encircled for seven days. 31 By faith the harlot Rahab did not perish with those who did not believe, when she had received the spies with peace. 33 who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, 34 quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, became valiant in battle, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

Shiloh

became the first resting place of the tabernacle of God, even before Jerusalem.

Shiloh has recently been unearthed. it is situated just 10 miles north of Bethel today. it's a beautiful place, vacated and quiet, there are only ruins remaining there now.

1.) Chapter 11: Faith

The Thrust of Chapter 11 is verses 6-9

Revelation 19:19

And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. (KJV)

But Why Not Keep The Horses and Chariots? because the Canaanites trusted in them and God would not have Israel do the Same

these enemies were awesome in power and might. they were bigger in size, stronger in arms and better at war than Israel. it would have been easy to begin to trust in the war machines of man!

Israel was to Advance in the Spirit

Psalm 20:7

Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of the LORD our God.

God's People

David

1 Samuel 17:49-50

Then David put his hand in his bag and took out a stone; and he slung it and struck the Philistine in his forehead, so that the stone sank into his forehead, and he fell on his face to the earth.

a.) Faith Renounces Defeat

vv. 1-5

And it came to pass, when Jabin king of Hazor heard these things, that he sent to Jobab king of Madon, to the king of Shimron, to the king of Achshaph, 2 and to the kings who were from the north, in the mountains, in the plain south of Chinneroth, in the lowland, and in the heights of Dor on the west, 3 to the Canaanites in the east and in the west, the Amorite, the Hittite, the Perizzite, the Jebusite in the mountains, and the Hivite below Hermon in the land of Mizpah. 4 So they went out, they and all their armies with them, as many people as the sand that is on the seashore in multitude, with very many horses and chariots. 5 And when all these kings had met together, they came and camped together at the waters of Merom to fight against Israel.

the waters of Merom

was the Rallying Point This Massive Military Coalition assembled at Merom, just a few miles north of the sea of Galilee. Josephus writes that the combined armies numbered 300,000 foot soldiers, 20,000 chariots and 10,000 horsemen.

b.) Faith **Results** in Victory

vv. 6-14

But the LORD said to Joshua, "Do not be afraid because of them, for tomorrow about this time I will deliver all of them slain before Israel. You shall hamstring their horses and burn their chariots with fire." 7 So Joshua and all the people of war with him came against them suddenly by the waters of Merom, and they attacked them. 8 And the LORD delivered them into the hand of Israel, who defeated them and chased them to Greater Sidon, to the Brook Misrephoth, and to the Valley of Mizpah eastward; they attacked them until they left none of them remaining. 9 So Joshua did to them as the LORD had told him: he hamstrung their horses and burned their chariots with fire.

7 So Joshua and all the people of war with him came against them suddenly by the waters of Merom, and they attacked them. 8 And the LORD delivered them into the hand of Israel,

The Victory At Merom

Led to the Destruction of Hazor - this was the capitol of the Region

From Gilgal to Merom

is a five day walk by foot.

Joshua Had Time to Think

that is not always a good thing unless our thoughts have been dedicated to God

Joshua mounted, not a defensive posture, but an offensive attack, he ran toward the enemy

Matthew 11:28-30

"Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

29 "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 "For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

Joshua turned back at that time and took Hazor, and struck its king with the sword; for Hazor was formerly the head of all those kingdoms. 11 And they struck all the people who were in it with the edge of the sword, utterly destroying them. There was none left breathing. Then he burned Hazor with fire. 12 So all the cities of those kings, and all their kings, Joshua took and struck with the edge of the sword. He utterly destroyed them, as Moses the servant of the LORD had commanded. 13 But as for the cities that stood on their mounds, Israel burned none of them, except Hazor only, which Joshua burned. 14 And all the spoil of these cities and the livestock, the children of Israel took as booty for themselves; but they struck every man with the edge of the sword until they had destroyed them, and they left none breathing.

d) Faith **Requires** a Response

vv. 15-20

As the LORD had commanded Moses his servant, so Moses commanded Joshua, and so Joshua did. He left nothing undone of all that the LORD had commanded Moses. 16 Thus Joshua took all this land: the mountain country, all the South, all the land of Goshen, the lowland, and the Jordan plainthe mountains of Israel and its lowlands, 17 from Mount Halak and the ascent to Seir, even as far as Baal Gad in the Valley of Lebanon below Mount Hermon. He captured all their kings, and struck them down and killed them. 18 Joshua made war a long time with all those kings. 19 There was not a city that made peace with the children of Israel, except the Hivites, the inhabitants of Gibeon. All the others they took in battle. 20 For it was of the LORD to harden their hearts, that they should come against Israel in battle, that He might utterly destroy them, and that they might receive no mercy, but that He might destroy them, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

Verse 19-20

when difficulties Come to Our lives

Our Faith is Tested...

if we have saving faith, we will turn to God in the Trial if our faith is false and fairweathered, then we turn against God

James 1:2-4

My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, 3 knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. 4 But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

This Joy Comes From Knowing

That Your Faith is Being Proven - the very trial is evidence that God is at Work in Your Life.

Joshua 11:18

Joshua made war **a long time** with all those kings. (chapt. 14 tells us that the land was being purged of the enemies for seven years)

e.) Faith **Receives** God's Promises

vv. 21-23

And at that time Joshua came and cut off the Anakim from the mountains: from Hebron, from Debir, from Anab, from all the mountains of Judah, and from all the mountains of Israel; Joshua utterly destroyed them with their cities. 22 None of the Anakim were left in the land of the children of Israel; they remained only in Gaza, in Gath, and in Ashdod. 23 So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the LORD had said to Moses; and Joshua gave it as an inheritance to Israel according to their divisions by their tribes. Then the land rested from war. according to all that the LORD had said to Moses;

- The Words of the Prophet Moses Had Come True
 - The Words of General Joshua Had Come True,
 - Because God Had Spoken a Promise

Numbers 13:32-33

..."The land through which we have gone as spies, is a land that devours its inhabitants, and all the people whom we saw in it are men of great stature. 33 "There we saw the giants (the descendants of Anak who came from the giants); and we were like grasshoppers in our own sight, ...and so we were in their sight."

"There we saw the giants (the sons of Anak... and we were like grasshoppers in our own sight, ...and so we were in their sight."

Israel had heard about the giants, they had thought about the giants, they had worried about the giants...

Joshua and Caleb Had Said

"Far Out" - Let's Watch God Kick Their Giant Rears

Joshua 11:19-20

There was not a city that made peace with the children of Israel, except the Hivites, the inhabitants of Gibeon. All the others they took in battle. 20 For it was of the LORD to harden their hearts, that they should come against Israel in battle, that He might utterly destroy them, and that they might receive no mercy, but that He might destroy them, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

A Warning to You About What You Believe

Eventually, God will let you alone where You're at and With What You Believe.

Verse 19

is an Invitation to Change Your Mind Verse 20 is The Judgement that Comes to Every Man if He doesn't Change His Mind

Example of Man's Hardening

Exodus 8:15

But when Pharaoh saw that there was relief, Pharaoh hardened his heart and did not heed them, as the LORD had said he would.

Example of God's Hardening

Exodus 4:21

And the LORD said to Moses, "When you go back to Egypt, see that you do all those wonders before Pharaoh which I have put in your hand. But I will harden his heart, so that he will not let the people go.

if you keep standing in wet cement,

you'll eventually harden with it. you'll not be able to get out

The Day of Grace Will Soon Pass

At The Point of the Rapture of the Church, The Church Age Will Cease &

(The Time of Jacob's Trouble Will Begin)
It Will Be The Time of the Tribulation Saints

2 Thessalonians 2:3-12

Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, (people giving up on the faith) and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, 4 who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God. 5 Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you these things? 6 And now you know what is restraining, that he may be revealed in his own time. 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way. 8 And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming. 9 The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, 10 and

with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this reason God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, 12 that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

2 Thessalonians 1:7-10

...when the Lord Jesus Christ is revealed from heaven, with His mighty angels, 8 in flaming fire taking vengeance on all those who don't know God, and on those who did not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, when He comes, in that Day, to be glorified in His saints...

Every Time The Gospel Goes Out

2.) Chapter 12: Recaps the Victories Over the Kings

The Conquering of the Kings

33 kings are mentioned as being destroyed by Joshua.

Israel had taken the cities and the kings that were in power. as the inheritance was divided among Israel, each tribe then subdued their smaller, personal territory.
