The Roads That Led to the Cities of Refuge

#1 - had to be maintained and #2 - kept clear of obstacles #3 - and were made as straight as possible

A.) Kedesh, The City of Righteousness:

Kedesh

righteousness

is given to all those who flee to Christ because He

Romans 3:24-26

being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,
whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate
His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that
were previously committed, 26 to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness,
that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

B.) Shechem, The City of Burden:

Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong, because He poured out His soul unto death, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and He **bore (shouldered)** the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Roy Gustafson

The following day the avengers came and demanded that the slayer be handed over to avengers. but the priest said i have sworn an oath that this man have a fair investigation and trial. but sir this man is a killer and must be put to death, a life for a life. the priest responded again "i have sworn an oath to treat this man fair" but your honor, this man has killed your only son. - - the priest, shocked, dropped to his knees and with tears streaming down his face said "then this man is my son now. all that I have is his, and he is mine" with that the avengers went away.
