Now there were in the same country (*the region of Judah*) shepherds **living out** in the fields, **keeping watch** over their flock by night. :9 And behold, an angel of the Lord **stood before them**, and the glory of the Lord **shone around them**, and they were greatly afraid. :10 Then the angel said to them, "**Do not be afraid...**

# The Timing and Location of the Shepherds is Interesting.

They are Near Jerusalem and they are Near Bethlehem

many biblical historians believe  
that they were nearby because once each year during the day of atonement

This Would Have Been at The Time of the Fall Feasts  
and one of them would have been **The Day of Atonement**

During The Month on the Hebrew Calendar -  
September or October.

the Bible Celebrates the Feasts of Trumpets,  
**The Day of Atonement**, and The Feast of Tabernacles

## **THE DAY GOD CAME DOWN**

for these very important reasons...

### **BEFORE US IS THE GREATEST AND YET SIMPLEST STORY EVER TOLD**

**It's a perfect story if you'll allow it to be - for your life!**

- *"it has to do with love and world peace,*
- *it has to do with forgiveness and harmony,*
- *it has to do with eternity and angels"*

**this story is the single most important story  
that answers to all of man's worries and woes!**

**Psalm 107:20**

He sent His word and healed them,  
And delivered *them* from their destructions.

**John 11:25-26**

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. :26 And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"

*There was a public announcement*

**a.) it was made to the most common of people**

**v.8**

Now there were in the same country shepherds **living out** in the fields,  
**keeping watch** over their flock by night...

these are common, blue collar workers of the poorer class. (They Are Shepherds)

they were not allowed to be near the towns or cities because they were very despised and viewed as thieves and social rejects.

the shepherd was despised in Jesus' day.  
usually uneducated, poor and nomadic, the shepherd could not focus on the daily requirements of the law. he couldn't keep the requirements of hand washings and rituals.

Because of This Disdain for Shepherds - many would have children tend the sheep when Possible (i.e. david)

## But Notice with Me Please

the shepherd had to choose between religious practices  
or raising sheep, tending to the sheep and supplying sheep or keeping the regulations.

Jesus is the Good Shepherd  
who chose to raise up and to tend and to supply the sheep.

**John 10:11**

"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.

**John 10:14-16**

I am the good shepherd; and I know My *sheep*, and am known by My own. :15 As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. :16 And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock *and* one shepherd.

**b.) it was made to the most lofty of angels**

**vs.9-10**

And behold, an angel of the Lord **stood before them**, and the glory of the Lord **shone around them**, and they were greatly afraid. :10 Then the angel said to them, “**Do not be afraid...**

Angels - The Premier Servants of God

**Hebrews 1:14**

Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?

## The Role of Angels

they receive and implement the Lord's will in heaven and on earth

they are created beings / once created, they are eternal / they have emotions / they have a will / they are self determinate / they are independent

**II.) There was a sample of heaven**

**v.10b-14**

**10b for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people.** :11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. :12 And this *will be* the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger.” :13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: :14 “Glory to God in the highest, And **on earth peace, goodwill toward men!**”

*There was a sample of heaven*

**a.) God was now among man**

**vs10b-11**

....10b for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people.

good tidings = glad, happy, joyous news = **the gospel !**

great joy = over abundance of well being = **satisfaction !**

all people = to any and all who will listen = **to those who receive !**

**I've got something to say, this gospel satisfies those who receive it**

For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior,  
who is Christ the Lord.

Notice with me please;  
this is the "Doctrine of the Incarnation of God" to earth in human form.

## **KNOWN AS THE "IMMANUEL"**

it involved the Lord, **becoming** a man, a human being.  
it involved the Lord **limiting** Himself to humanity.  
it involved the Lord **staying** a human being for all time and eternity.

## **The Savior, The Christ, The Lord**

what saves? the savior, What Christ, The Deliverer, What Lord? our Master

## **The Saviour is Christ = The Messiah**

Jesus is not Only our Savior, Messiah  
but was also our Sacrifice.

### **Hebrews 13:12-13**

Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, **suffered outside the gate.** (of the city of Jerusalem) :13 Therefore let us go forth to Him, **outside the camp,**

### **Leviticus 16:27**

for the sin offering whose blood was brought in to make atonement  
in the Holy *Place*, shall be carried **outside the camp.**

### **Hebrews 9:11-12**

But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect  
tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation.....

### **...Hebrews 9:12 cont.**

Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once  
for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

God the Son  
now wrapped in human flesh...

## John 1:14

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

## the sign

shmei<sup>v</sup>on semeion, *say-mi'-on*;  
the announcement, the indication,  
also translated miracle, a token, a pledge or wonder.

The Sign is The Miracle, The Token, The Announcement is  
That...

"You will find your Salvation, Your Deliverer, Your Master,  
Lord Now Among You"

## John 1:29

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

## 1 Timothy 1:15-16

This *is* a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief. **:16** However, for this reason I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show all longsuffering, as a pattern to those who are going to believe on Him for everlasting life.

## **Colossians 2:9**

For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily;

## **Colossians 1:14-16**

in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. :15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. :16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

## **John 6:46-48**

No one has seen the Father except the one who is from God; only he has seen the Father. :47 I tell you the truth, he who believes has everlasting life.:48 I am the bread of life.

## How Can This Be?

In Acoustics There is Something Called

### Sympathetic Resonances

it happens when you have two pianos that are exactly alike but separate. one is here and the other is there. if you to strike the key of one piano followed by the key of the other piano you would hear  
Sympathetic Resonance

the same chord, the same key, the same sound  
coming from an exact copy of the original.

When we're Hurting - Jesus Resonates with Sympathy  
When we're scared - Jesus Resonates with Peace  
When we're tired - Jesus Resonates with Strength.

### Sympathetic Resonance is What 2 Corinthians 12:9-10 Is About Spiritually

And He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.”  
Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.  
:10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for  
Christ’s sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

**Hebrews 4:14-16**

He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and **acquainted** with grief.

**oAd yada{**, *yaw-dah´*

to know well, to be in association with, to discover, to be familiar with.

**v.15-16**

# Notice With Me The Action (Activity or Uction)

What The Lord has Made Known to You,  
you know you must do something about.

Once We Know Something,  
We're now responsible to do what we can about it.

:15 the angels had **gone away** from them **back to heaven**,  
the shepherds said to one another, "**Let's go...** :16 And **they came** with **haste** and **found**  
(**searched**) Mary and Joseph, and the Babe lying in a manger.

## Verse 15-16

"**Let's go** to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us."

## This Happened, So Let's Go

### James 2:17-20

Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. :18 But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. :19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!  
:20 But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead?

*A decision had to be made*

**b.) It was to tell others about what they knew v.17-19**

:17 Now when they had seen *Him*, they made widely known the saying which was told them concerning this Child. :18 And all those who heard *it* marveled at those things which were told them by the shepherds. :19 But Mary kept all these things and pondered *them* in her heart.

Then the shepherds **returned, glorifying and praising** God  
(*why?*) for (*because*) all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told them.

it's one thing to visit the manger of the newborn Jesus  
and to peek inside;  
but it's a totally different thing to have a new birth  
take place inside of you.

## **Stop Peeking at Jesus**

(I've Been to London, I've Seen the Crown Jewels, But do you See the  
Crown Jewels on Me?)

I only had a chance to **peek** at them

### **John 3:1-7**

There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. **:2** This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him." **:3** Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." **:4** Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" **:5** Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. **:6** That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. **:7** Do not marvel that I said to you, "You must be born again."

we've heard the testimony of angels and shepherds and of those  
living in those days, but what about you personally?
