A Lepers Life

Leviticus 13:1 The LORD said to Moses and Aaron,

Leviticus 13:2 “When anyone has a swelling or a rash or a bright spot on his skin that may become an infectious skin disease, he must be brought to Aaron the priest or to one of his sons who is a priest.

Leviticus 13:3 The priest is to examine the sore on his skin, and if the hair in the sore has turned white and the sore appears to be more than skin deep, it is an infectious skin disease. When the priest examines him, he shall pronounce him ceremonially unclean.

BECAUSE THE LORD IS AT WORK

1c.) He is closing the gap on my life

v.12b

...who stood afar off!

Leviticus 13:46 He shall be unclean. All the days he has the sore he shall be unclean. He *is* unclean, and he shall dwell alone; his dwelling *shall be* outside the camp.

2.) Because the Lord Is aware

v.13-14

:13 And they **lifted up their voices** and said, “**Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!**”

:14 So when He saw *them*, He said to them, “**Go, show yourselves to the priests.**”

And so it was that as they went, they were **cleansed**.

But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead?

This is Encouraging as they were lepers, being lepers, walking lepers they came.

Matthew 11:28

Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Isaiah 1:18

“Come now, and let us reason together,” Says the LORD, “Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool.

But You Must Come to Him
and your first step in coming is your first step of faith

Romans 4:3

For what does the Scripture say? *“Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.”*

:14 So when He **saw them**, He **said** to them, **“Go, show yourselves to the priests.”**

I mean, it's going to look pretty stupid if we're going to the chapel with leprosy all
over our faces...”

v.14b

:15 And one of them, **when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, :16 and fell down on his face at (on) His feet, giving Him thanks. And he (only) was a Samaritan.**

3a.) He is worthy of praise v.15

And one of them, **when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God,**

3b.) He is worthy of thanks v.16a

and fell down on his face at (on) His feet, giving Him thanks.

3c.) He is worthy of all v.16b

...And he (only) was a Samaritan.

4.) Because the Lord is salvation v.17-19

:17 So Jesus answered and said, **“Were there not ten cleansed? But where *are* the nine? :18 Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?” :19 And He said to him, “Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well.”**

4a.) He reaches out to all v.17

So Jesus answered and said,
“Were there not ten cleansed? But where *are* the nine?”

4b.) He reaches out to one v.18

Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?”

BECAUSE THE LORD IS SALVATION

4c.) He reaches out to you

v.19

And He said to him, “**Arise,**
go your way. Your faith has made you well.”

Leviticus 14:1-7

Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, **:2** “This shall be the law of the leper for the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought to the priest. **:3** And the priest shall go out of the camp, and the priest shall examine *him*; and indeed, *if* the leprosy is healed in the leper, **:4** then the priest shall command to take for him who is to be cleansed two living *and* clean birds, cedar wood, scarlet, and hyssop. **:5** And the priest shall command that one of the birds be killed in an earthen vessel over running water. **:6** As for the living bird, he shall take it, the cedar wood and the scarlet and the hyssop, and dip them and the living bird in the blood of the bird *that was* killed over the running water. **:7** And he shall sprinkle it seven times on him who is to be cleansed from the leprosy, and shall pronounce him clean, and shall let the living bird loose in the open field.
