1 Peter 1:10-12

:10 Of **this salvation the prophets** have **inquired** and **searched** carefully, who **prophesied** of the **grace** that **would come to you**, **:11** **searching** what, or what **manner** of time, **the Spirit of Christ** who was in **them** was **indicating** when He **testified beforehand** of **the sufferings** of Christ and **the glories** that would follow. **:12** To **them** (prophets) it was **revealed** that, not to **themselves**, but **to us they** were **ministering** the things which now have been **reported** to you through those who have **preached the gospel** to you by **the Holy Spirit** sent from heaven – things which angels **desire** to look into.

Luke 24:25-27

Then He said to them, “O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! **26** Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?” **27** And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He **expounded** to them in **all** the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.

Revelation 19:10

And I (John) fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, “See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have **the testimony of Jesus**.
Worship God! For **the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.**”

The Greatest Teaching On Bible Prophecy Ever, Teaches Us “What” has God said about Salvation!

1.) Is what God has said about Salvation vs. 10

:10 Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you,

1a.) His salvation is a forethought vs. 10a

1b.) His salvation is a knowable vs. 10b

1c.) His salvation is an experience vs. 10c

The Greatest Teaching On Bible Prophecy Ever, Teaches Us “How” would God Provide Salvation!

2.) Is how God would provide Salvation vs. 11

:11 searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand of the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.

2a.) He ordained the time of salvation vs. 11a

2b.) He inspired the revelation of salvation vs. 11b

2c.) He testified of the origin of salvation vs. 11c

Jesus Christ, of course in His earthly ministry,

personified all that God had written in His Word, the Bible. It is;

(1) The Bible that reveals to us God **promises** to save. (2) It is God’s **pleasure** to save. (3) It is God’s **prerogative**

Romans 5:1-2, 6,8

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God **through** our Lord Jesus Christ, **2** through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand...

:6 For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, **Christ died for us.**

Jesus Christ is the substitute for all things, but nothing can be a substitute for Jesus Christ” **Dr. Harry Ironside**

The Greatest Teaching On Bible Prophecy Ever, Is “Who God Would grant Salvation to”

3.) Is who God would grant Salvation to vs. 12

:12 To **them** (prophets) it was **revealed** that, not to **themselves**, but **to us they** were **ministering** the things which now have been **reported** to you through those who have **preached the gospel** to you by **the Holy Spirit** sent from heaven – things which **angels desire** to look into.

3a.) Salvation is central to the revelation vs. 12a

:12 To **them** (prophets) it was **revealed**

The (Prophet then) and the (Christian now)
Neither they nor we have any message of our own to give.

The Christian Minister is not called to manufacture anything – we are all called to repeat only what God has said.

We say what has been revealed.

(there is no new truth – there is only God’s truth and truth is as eternal as God is because He is truth itself)

Salvation is central to the revelation

John 14:6a

Jesus said, “I am **the Way, the Truth, and the Life.**”

1 Corinthians 15:3-4

For I delivered to you **first of all** that which **I also received:**

(1) that Christ died for our sins according to the **Scriptures, 4** and that (2) He was **buried,** and (3) that He **rose again** the third day according to the **Scriptures,**

1 Corinthians 1:17

For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel,

3b.) Salvation is for all who receive

vs. 12b

:12b that, not to **themselves**, but **to us they** were **ministering** the things which now have been **reported** to you through those who have **preached the gospel** to you

John 1:10-12

He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. 11 He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. 12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

This "Salvation" is received in many ways but every one of those "ways" - - brings the sinner to the same place, same conclusion, to the Same Door.

I met Allen this past Friday, he is a Pharmacist.

Allen was invited by a friend to come to church here 9 years ago. He heard the Gospel, went off to UCLA and sought out Christians and later prayed to receive Christ!

What about you – what is your personal testimony?

3c.) Salvation is of God, Who provides God

vs. 12c

:12c by **the Holy Spirit** sent from heaven – things which **angels desire** to look into.

The Centrality of This Salvation was not just that **of the prophets**, not just that **of the Holy Spirit**, not just that **of the Apostles**, - - but it was also that **of the Angels**.

!!! And it's to be our personal centrality as Christians !!!

It is our privilege to know that we are saved.

:12c things which angels desire to look into.

According to the Bible, Angels are fascinated by God's ministry toward Humans.

things which **angels desire to look into.**

Angels grk: aggelos; heavenly messengers. Angelic entities. Beings.
(message bearers or messengers of or from the spirit realm)

things which **angels desire to look into.**

Since no man is excluded from calling upon God, the gate of salvation is open to all.

There is nothing else that hinders us from entering, but one's own unbelief

Daniel 4:13b

Behold, a **watcher**, a holy one came down from heaven;

Daniel 4:17

This decision is by the decree of the **watchers**, and the sentence by the word of the holy ones, in order that the living may know that the Most High rules in the kingdom of men,

Hebrews 1:14

Are they (angels / watchers) not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?

**But there's one verse that, for me, ties
it all together perfectly in Technicolor.**

they witness this...

1 Timothy 3:16

That without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was
manifested in the flesh, **justified** in the Spirit, **seen** by angels,

Seen op'-tom-ahee; is to gaze at or upon something or someone with intense interests; to open wide the eyes or to be wild-eyed; to stare at something remarkable; not a voluntary observation but rather an earnest, continued inspection; to be held captive by what is being observed.

Then they quickly appear to say that...

Luke 2:10-11,13-14

Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for **behold**, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. **11** For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. **:13** And **suddenly** there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host **praising** God and saying **: 14 "Glory** to God in the highest,

I wonder how often these Watchers/Angels must listen to us and see us and hear us say the dumbest things.

From Genesis to Revelation the Bible has a preoccupation

with the doctrine / teaching of salvation. In fact, when we look into eternity we see the continual worship that the redeemed express to the Lamb of God...

Revelation 5:9-14

And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, **10** And have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth." **:11** Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands..**8 ...12** saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!" **:13** And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under

the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!" :14 Then the four living creatures said, "Amen!" And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever.

You will find all true theology summed up in these two short sentences:

Salvation is all of the grace of God. **Damnation** is all of the will of man.
