ABOUT our PURPOSE

Swordsmen's Club is the Bible Memory Program specifically developed for 1st-6th graders. During this three-year program, your child will learn many portions of Scripture that will help shape their faith and ultimately encourage them to surrender their lives to Christ.

We have selected key Bible passages that focus on God's love, salvation, prayer, obedience, and praise. It is our hope that you and your child can work together as a family to memorize Scripture.

We pray that we will be able to build on the foundation you are laying at home. As your child memorizes God's Word, he/she will be able to live out 2 Timothy 2:15, "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the Word of God." It is our earnest desire that you participate with us by encouraging your child to learn the Scriptures and that God may richly bless your family as you study together.

Swordsmen's Club Weekly Verses

Verses are assigned weekly for children and parents to work on together. These verses must be recited on the date they are assigned to receive credit. (See the schedule on pages 4-9) If you are going to be absent, you can make up the verse up to one week late.

Children who recite weekly verses will earn \$10 Bible Bucks. If parents recite the weekly verse, children will earn an additional \$10 Bible Bucks.

Super Swordsmen Bonus Challenge

Bonus Passages (see page 10) add an extra challenge to the Swordsmen's Club. Children who complete the Bonus Passages, in addition to the weekly verses, will be honored during our Medal Ceremony in the Main Sanctuary. They will also receive a special reward after completion.

Children can recite Bonus Passages any Sunday throughout the year. All Bonus Passages must be completed by Sunday, April 24th.

Children will earn \$30 Bible Bucks for every completed Bonus Passage.

ELITE Super Swordsman Challenge

6th graders also have the option of participating in the 6th Grade ELITE Super Swordsman Challenge. The ELITE Super Swordsman Challenge requires 6th graders to memorize not only the weekly verses and the 6 Bonus Passages, but to memorize an additional 6 Elite Passages (see page 11).

They can recite the passages at the Children's Ministry Table at any time during the year, when they feel ready. 6th graders should complete at least **1-2 passages a month** to finish the ELITE Super Swordsman Challenge on time.

6th graders who complete the ELITE Super Swordsman Challenge will be honored with a special medal at our Medal Ceremony in the Main Sanctuary. They will also receive an invitation to our Super Secret Overnighter.

They must complete all required Bonus and Elite Passages by Sunday, April 24th (see pages 10 & 11). 6th Graders will earn \$30 Bible Bucks for every completed Elite Passage.
