### Matthew 17:1-3

....Now after six days Jesus took **Peter, James, and John** his brother, led them up on a high mountain by themselves; <sup>2</sup> and He was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light. <sup>3</sup> And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to **them**, talking with **Him**.

Peter, James & John  
were privy to many special-ed classes by Jesus

### “Seeing the Kingdom Come”

was obviously a huge boost  
to their spiritual growth and understanding

But The Kingdom  
is all ready at work here and at work

### Luke 17:20-21

Now when He was asked by the Pharisees **when** the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation; <sup>21</sup> "nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you."

Jesus was NOT declaring that the kingdom of  
GOD is within everyone

The Question was  
“**When**” - - would the kingdom come?

Jesus’ Answer was Provocative and Curious

"The kingdom of God does **not** come  
**with observation;**

(IT DOES COME...*but not with observation.*)

(Parateresis (par-at-ay'-ray-sis)

visual analysis or inspection, or by ocular evidence:

nor will they say, 'See **here!**' or 'See **there!**'

It's Not Subject to a Geographically Local

It's not found on the temple mount, nor among the sanctums of the court, not is the kingdom found in the sanctuary nor behind the veil of the Holy of Holies. It cannot be found in temples of stone or gold or traditions...

For indeed, the kingdom of God  
is **within you.**"

en'tos homo'ne

(Inside a human)

**Ezekiel 36:26-27**

"I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. <sup>27</sup> "I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.

**John 14:16-17**

"And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another **Helper**, that **He** may abide with you forever-- <sup>17</sup> "**even the Spirit of truth**, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees **Him** nor knows **Him**; but you know **Him**, for **He dwells with you** and shall be **IN YOU!**

### Philippians 3:20-21

For our **citizenship** is in heaven, from which we also  
**eagerly wait** for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>21</sup> who will **transform** our lowly  
body that it may be **conformed** to His **glorious body**, according to the working by  
which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

### 1 Corinthians 15:51-52

Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed— <sup>52</sup> in a  
moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and  
the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

**Job 19:25-26**

For I know that my Redeemer lives, and He shall stand at last on the earth; <sup>26</sup> And after my skin is destroyed, this I know, that in my flesh I shall see God,

**2c.) We Shall Inherit His Love**

Verse 2c

for we shall see Him as He is.

**2 Corinthians 12:2-4**

I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago-- whether in the body I do not know, or whether out of the body I do not know, God knows-- such a one was caught up to the third heaven. <sup>3</sup> And I know such a man-- whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows-- <sup>4</sup> how he was caught up into Paradise and heard inexpressible words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter.
