Verse 16

16 And we have **known** and **believed** the love that God has for us.
God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.

Ever Christian can receive

His comfort Because God has set His love upon us in a very
powerful way.

We need to realize how much He loves us at all times.

John 15:9

"As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you;
abide (continue on) in My love.

What's Love Got To Do With It?

2.) God's love is a powerful love

vv. 17-18

Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. ¹⁸ There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

What's Love Got To Do With It?

2a.) Love makes us bold and daring in this world

Verse 17

Love has been **perfected** among us in this: **that we may have boldness in the day of judgment;** because as He is, so are we in this world.

Because He loves us,
with a total and complete love there is nothing for us to be nervous about especially when the on the day of judgement. This boldness causes us to be as confident in this world as Jesus was.

John 15:13

"Greater (bold) love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

What's Love Got To Do With It?

2b.) Love overpowers all of our fears

Verse 18

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

When we believe that God

Really does love us, then nothing can conquer us or defeat us because we are the object of His love. When we do not believe in Him, then we are fearful, timid and unproductive.

3.) *God's love is a creative love*

vv. 19-20

We love Him because He first loved us. ²⁰ If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen?

What's Love Got To Do With It?

3a.) *Love originates with God alone*

Verse 19

We love Him because He first loved us.

We cannot take any credit
at all for having loved God because He not only loved us first
but he loved us the best, from the beginning.

3b.) Love reaches out beyond our boundaries

Verse 20

If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar;
for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen,
how can he love God whom he has not seen?

love others as if the other were God standing before them.

4.) God's love is a motivating love

And this commandment we have from Him:
