It Matters What You Believe!!!

What we **believe** becomes the object of our **faith**.

That faith naturally produces a **love** for what we believe.

That **love** and devotion that we have, keeps us **faithful** to what we **believe**.

v. 2

By this we know that we **love** the children of God,
when we **love** God and **keep** His commandments.

Loving God Leads to Honoring God

John 13:34

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you,
that you also love one another.

The Commandments of God

are holy, just and true; we strive at keeping them not because we'll be
accepted by God for the keeping of them, but now that we know God
personally - - we love all that He is about!

c.) His commandments become our pleasure

v. 3

For this is the love of God, that we **keep** His commandments.
And His commandments are not burdensome.

Our Faith is an Overcoming Faith

a.) *We will overcome through faith*

v. 4

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world

Turn to Hebrews 11:33

Hebrews 11:33

who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,

Hebrews 11:33-39

who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, 34 quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, became valiant in battle, turned to flight the armies of the aliens. 35 Women received their dead raised to life again. And others were tortured, not accepting deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection.

36 Still others had trial of mockings and scourgings, yes, and of chains and imprisonment. 37 They were stoned, they were sawn in two, were tempted, were slain with the sword. They wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins, being destitute,

afflicted, tormented-- 38 of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, in dens and caves of the earth. 39 And all these, having obtained a good testimony through faith...

Romans 1:17

For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "**The just shall live by faith.**"

The Believer's Faith

b.) *We will overcome by faith*

v. 4b

And this is the victory that has overcome the world
-- **our faith.**

Like an Olympic Sprinter,

that athlete has come to have faith in his power, his speed, his endurance by his training, his discipline, and his experience so that by the time he enters those starting blocks,
he believes that he will win...

That Sprinter, at that point,
believes that he will overcome, **by faith,**
because at that moment after all the preparation is done, and when there is no more time remaining to make ready, he goes with what he knows...

Victory grk 3529 nike (nee'-kay);
To be the victor, the conquest, the means of success is victory

Nike

(Nee' kay)

Meaning That We Have Already Become Victor's and that We Compete from The Position of Having Already been declared the champion!

WHAT Nike DOES

Romans 12:1-2

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Evil Must Always Bow to Us

Romans 6:13-14

And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God. 14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

Faith Must Always Overcome Darkness

Romans 10:9-17

that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame." 12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. 13 For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." 14 How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? 15 And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things!" 16 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" 17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

c.) *We will overcome *in* faith*

v. 5

Who is he who overcomes the world?
but he who **believes** that Jesus is the Son of God?

Who is he who (overcomes) the world?

A contender who fights a fight, gets bruised, gets cut, feels the aches and pains but continues the struggle until he reaches what was already his.

1 Timothy 6:12

Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life!!!

2 Timothy 4:7-8

I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 8 Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.

The Book of Revelation

tells us that those who become Christians during the tribulation period will be required to die for their faith in Jesus Christ

Revelation 12:11

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Jude 1:3

Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to **contend earnestly** for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.

a.) *The trinity in heaven*

v. 6

This is He who came by water and blood-- Jesus Christ; not only by water, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who bears witness, because the Spirit is truth

There are Two General Opinions Regarding this Text

#1

Being Baptized in Water at the Jordan River and in Blood at his cross

#2

Being the Water that Flowed from his side as well as Blood at the cross

And Then There's My Opinion

#3

Being born into this world through water, and the blood meaning his earthly flesh offered upon the cross

Jesus' Conception was of Divine means But Jesus' Birth was of a Human Nature

Isaiah 7:14

"Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

Matthew 1:18

Now **the birth** of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, **she was found with child of the Holy Spirit.**

Luke 2:11

"For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

John 18:37

Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. **For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world...**

not His mouth.

That's Why Jesus Said to Nic...

John 3:5-7

...Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born of water** and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. 6 That which is **born of the flesh is flesh**; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. 7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born **again**.

Verse 7

For there are three that bear witness in heaven: the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one.

{this verse was not found in ancient manuscripts prior to the tenth (10th) century that we know of. However, it was present during the time when the King James translators produced the Bible in English and those translators argued that the text was faithful to the doctrine of the trinity}

The Variation here in verse 7 does nothing to the biblical doctrine

John 1:1,14

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God...
14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us...

b.) The witness of heaven

v. 9-10

If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater; for this is the witness of God which He has testified of His Son. 10 He who believes in the Son of God has the witness in himself; he who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed the testimony that God has given of His Son.

In God's Rule of Law...

Deuteronomy 19:15

...by the mouth of two or three witnesses the matter shall be established.

We have an inner witness to the truth

Romans 8:16

The Holy Spirit Himself bears witness with our human spirit
that we are children of God,

c.) The testimony of God

v. 11-12

And this is the testimony:
that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. 12 He who has the Son
has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

**The Christian knows
that he has God's life in him**
