Summation Sentence of Text

Christian fellowship is an opportunity that should be held at a premium by all of us. Our coming together as a church and as a ministry is to be a top priority of our lives. When we break fellowship, we break unity. When we break unity, we lose our vision and when we have lost our vision we lose our way...

And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. 25

Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us

encourage one another-- and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

But one of the great dangers we face as Christians is the temptation of becoming lazy in spiritual things. When that happens is when we begin to lose a heart for fellowship. We lose the desire to Fellowship with each other, and ultimately we lose the desire to fellowship with God Himself through prayer...

Over and Over Again in Scripture we are Challenged to Pray and to Keep Praying.

We're Encouraged to Stay at it and to not Quit...

1 Thessalonians 5:17 pray without ceasing, - keep breathing!!!

Charles Spurgeon, the great preacher of yester year once said that "The Prayer meeting is the Lungs of the Church"

"A Christian without Prayer Is like a Man without Air"

Being Without Air

You and I will suffer greatly!

We will at first notice nothing, but very soon we will feel stressed internally, then fear quickly attacks until panic sets in and finally there is a violent struggle, then personification of apathy!!!

The Kursk

The Russian Sub-mariners aboard the Kursk ran out of Air

Did you know that from our listening posts in Stuttgart Germany and from the coast of Norway the United States Navy and the CIA listened to the entire accident take place in real time. Did you know that U.S. Naval intelligence could hear the impact, the tearing of the twin hulls, the explosions of the forward torpedoes and then the water flooding that submarine and the men drowning from a lack of air!

Jane's Intelligence Agency Tells us the United States Listened to the Accident Take Place while Moscow was not even aware of the incident for nearly 12 hours. Moscow later became aware of it from international news reports on CNN...

When Air is Running Out, There Isn't Much Time

And when prayer is running low, that's when it's time to pause for power

Pausing for Power

a.) To speak the truth of God

V. 14

Now this is the **confidence** that we have in Him,

When we Pause for Power We can speak the truth of God +/-

Acts 1:4,8

And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me...... 8 "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you;

and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the earth."

Acts 4:29

"Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word,

Acts 4:31

And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

b.) To talk to God with assurance

V. 14

Why Don't I Ask More Often And for More of what God wants for Me?

Luke 11:9-10

"So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 10 "For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

according to His will, He hears us

Does God Always Hear Us?

Isaiah 59:1-2

Surely the arm of the LORD is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear. 2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.

Isaiah 1:15

When you spread out your hands, I will hide My eyes from you; even though you make many prayers, I will not hear. Your hands are full of evil.

The Key to Answered Prayer is Learning to Pray in Line with His Will

c.) To know what is ours in Christ

V. 15

And if **we know** that He hears us, whatever we ask, **we know** that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

the thing asked for. A request for a desired thing. (person, place or thing) – in Christ !!!

Listen to Paul's "Delighting" Heart as he Prays

Ephesians 3:14-20

For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ 15 from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named 16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man 17 that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love 18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height-- 19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. 20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us.

a.) Of watching out for one another

V. 16

If anyone sees his brother sinning a sin...

Galatians 6:1

Brothers, if someone is **caught (overtaken)** in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently. But watch yourself, or you also may be tempted.

stuck. tangled up. to be surprised.

This is All of Our Ministry That is, The Welfare of our Brothers

Genesis 4:8-9

Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him. 9 Then the LORD said to Cain, "Where is Abel your brother?" He said, "I do not know. Am I my brother's keeper?"

"Am I my brother keeper?" Yes, you certainly are...

b.) Of praying for one another

V. 16

If anyone sees his brother sinning a sin which does not lead to death, he will ask, and He will give him life for those who commit sin not leading to death

he (that is you and I) will ask (that is to pray) and HE

(that is God) will give him life (Restoration)

Luke 23:33-34

And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left. 34 Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do."

We All Need Prayer (Do You Pray For Me?)

Ephesians 6:18-19

Pray all the time. Ask God for anything in line with the Holy Spirit's wishes. Plead with him, reminding him of your needs, and keep praying earnestly for all Christians everywhere. 19 Pray for me, too, and ask God to give me the right words as I boldly tell others about the Lord and as I explain to them that his salvation is for the Gentiles too.

We're taught in the book of James...

James 5:13-15

Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms. 14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. 15 And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

Grants us the Ministry

c.) Of caring for one another

V. 16-17

1 Corinthians 11:29-30

For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. 30 For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep.

But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself? 4 "While it remained, was it not your own? And after it was sold, was it not in your own control? Why have you conceived this thing in your heart? You have not lied to men but to God." 5 Then Ananias, hearing these words, fell down and breathed his last. So great fear came upon all those who heard these things. 6 And the young men arose and wrapped him up, carried him out, and buried him.

V. 18

We know that whoever is born of God does not sin;

practices a sin – stays at it – continues on in it

Romans 7:18

I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out.

Galatians 2:20

"I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Romans 6:11-12

Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord. 12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts.

V. 18

V. 19

We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one.

V. 20

c.) By calling us to share in His mission

V. 21

Little children, keep yourselves from idols. **Amen**.
