BACKGROUND

THE EARLY CHURCH was plagued with those of whom the scriptures warned about – some were the Judaizers, those who taught that believing in Jesus Christ was the first step to salvation and keeping Mosaic law was the second. Then there was the False Apostles who attacked Paul because of his ministry of the grace of God toward sinners. Thirdly there was the Gnostics. These were determined to reinterpret the scriptures and often spiritualize what was literal. They frequently detracted from the deity of Jesus Christ and undermined the revelation of God.

THESE FALSE BREATHERN had two things in common, #1 – was that they constantly asked this question which was... Who was Jesus Christ? They taught that He was anything but what John and the Apostle of God taught. And #2 – They professed to be true Christians! II John is the Apostles response to this aberrant teaching of the day.

Matthew 24:1-5

Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. 2 And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down." 3 Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?" 4 And Jesus answered and said to them: "Take heed that no one deceives you. 5 "For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many.

THE ELDER

The greek word presboteros is used here which can mean #1 – Old man in age, #2 - a senior person to respect or #3 – an official of the church

Truth by nature demands adherence.

v. 3

c.) Faith comes in knowing the way

vv. 4-6

I rejoiced greatly that I have found some of your children **walking in truth**, as we received commandment from the Father

This is love, that we walk according to His commandments. This is the commandment, that as you have heard from the beginning, you should **walk** in it = (truth, love, the way)

For many deceivers have gone out into the world

((Meaning, they once attended your church))

2 Peter 2:1-2

But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction. 2 And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed.

b.) Hope results in anticipation

v. 8

Look to yourselves, **that we do not lose those things we worked for**, but that we may receive a full reward

Look to yourselves

or be warned, be on guard

vv. 9-11

Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son 10 If anyone comes to you and does not bring this doctrine, do not receive him into your house nor greet him 11 for he who greets him shares in his evil deeds

to add or make additions. To run ahead of, to go out of bounds, to break a rope or restraint.

False Prophets

Add scriptures and doctrines to what has already been given

Revelation 22:18

For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book;

Deuteronomy 4:2

"You shall not add to the word which I command you, nor take anything from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

Verse 10-11

If anyone comes to you and does not bring this doctrine, do not receive him into your house nor greet him 11 for he who greets him shares in his evil deeds

to assist them in anyway is to contribute to the attack of Christ

do **not receive** him into your house **nor greet** him

do **not receive** him into your house (also because of demonic influences)

nor greet him

(do not give them a benediction)

The Children's Version

II John 1:10

If anyone comes to your house to teach you, and he doesn't believe what Christ taught His church, don't even invite him into your home. Don't even encourage him in any way.

The Nearly Inspired Version

II John 1:10

If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not take him into your house or welcome him.

In Communication / At Fellowship / To Bless

Love is a verb, and it demands action. It cannot be verbally expressed without it taking tangible forms.

What Good is Hidden Love?

Proverbs 27:5
An open rebuke is better than love carefully concealed.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love... (but note what actively follows love and proves it) joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. (Tangibles)

a.) Love desires to communicate

v.12

Having many things to write to you,
