Matthew 28:18-20

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "**All authority** has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. **:19 Go therefore** and **make disciples** of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **:20 teaching them to observe all things** that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the world."

Matthew 9:9-11

As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, "**Follow Me.**" **So he arose and followed Him.** **:10 ¶** Now it happened, as Jesus sat at the table in the house, *that* behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat down with Him and His disciples. **:11** And when the Pharisees saw *it*, they said to His disciples, "Why does your Teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?"

Noah Webster’s Dictionary Defines...

DIFFICULTY

That which is arduous. a thing that is hard to do or hard to understand; that which occasions labor, perplexity, hardship and requires perseverance. Something that is to be to overcome, solved, defeated. any obstacle which is between you and your intended goal.

1.) **Discovering God in the difficulty**

DISCOVERING GOD IN THE DIFFICULTY

1a.) **Discovering the purpose of difficulty**

That The LORD & His WORD is Man’s Deliverance

Counselors, Philosophers, Physiologist and Priests, where do they go when they need real help and real healing ?

The Bible Says...

Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they *were* naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings. :8 And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. :9 Then the LORD God **called to Adam** and said to him, **“Where are you?”**

Genesis 3:7-9

In Our Times of Trouble & Difficulty

He is with us...

The Bible Says...

He sent His word and healed them, And delivered *them* from their destructions.
Psalm 107:20

"Those who are sick"

for those who see their need, Jesus Christ is the sweetest of Comforters.

No one loves their eyesight more

then the man who has lost it.

Our Difficulty's Produce within us a **Depth of Purpose** and **Sagacity**
That otherwise would have never entered into our hearts or minds.

The Bible Says - Philippians 1:12-14

But I want you to know, brethren, that the things which happened to me have actually turned out for the furtherance of the gospel, :13 so that it has become evident to the whole palace guard, and to all the rest, that my chains are in Christ; :14 and most of the brethren in the Lord, having become confident by my chains, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.

How could this man Paul - think like that?
What made him different in the face of
difficulty?

I Knew Bible – Bible *thru and thru*

The Bible Says... Psalm 34:4

I **sought** the LORD, and He heard me, And **delivered** me from all my fears.

Comfort & Ease will never Ignite Faith.
(It can't cause the spark that drives the flame - - **only difficulty can**)

DISCOVERING GOD IN THE DIFFICULTY

1b.) Discovering **the fellowship** in the difficulty

Our God is the God of the Trenches

The Bible Says – 2 Corinthians 1:8-9

For we do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, of **our trouble** which came to us in Asia: that we were burdened beyond measure, above strength, **so that we despaired even of life.** :9 Yes, **we had the sentence of death in ourselves,** that **we should not trust in ourselves but in God** who raises the dead,

Philippians 3:8-10

Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ :9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which *is* from the law, but that which *is* through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith; :10 that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death,

DISCOVERING GOD IN THE DIFFICULTY

1c.) Discovering **the depth** to difficulty

What do we do when we're **hit with a difficulty**?

(As a Christian, I'm never hit with one – **it's special delivery** from His hand)

Do we go to the Word of God ?

There's a depth to understanding this...

The Bible Says - Philippians 1:20-21

according to my earnest expectation and hope **that in nothing** shall I be ashamed, but with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. :21 For to me, to live *is* Christ, and to die *is* gain.

Again - Philippians 1:28-29

do not in any way be terrified by your adversaries, which is to them a proof of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that from God. :29 For to you it has been granted on behalf of Christ, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake,

**What did Paul know that we can know
? – everything !!!**

The Bible Says - Isaiah 26:3

You will keep *him* in perfect peace, *Whose mind is stayed on You*, Because he trusts in You. :4 Trust in the LORD forever, For in **YAH**, (*The ROCK, SALVATION*) the LORD, *is everlasting strength.*

Job 23:10

But He knows the way that I take; *When* He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold.

2.) Developing maturity in the difficulty

The Bible Says – Philippians 3:10-15

that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, :11 if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead. :12 Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. :13 Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, :14 I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. :15 Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind;

DEVELOPING MATURITY IN THE DIFFICULTY

2a.) Difficulty develops faith

Every "**Faith-Lesson**" in the Bible
Was Prepared in Advance by a Difficulty.

What Do You Know About; Noah, Abraham, Joseph, Moses, Paul, The
Disciples?

The Bible Says – 1 Peter 1:5-7

who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. :6 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, :7 that the genuineness of your faith, *being* much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ,

Do This Next Time – Ask the Lord This;

"Father, this could not have come upon me without Your Approval. So then show me the way out of it that Honors You..."

2b.) Difficulty develops hope

WHEN HOPE IS LOST – WE CRASH.

But hope doesn't have to be lost – hope is never lost

For 3,000 years these verses have been free for the asking, in the Bible, God's #1 Best Seller..

The Bible Says - Psalm 42:3-5

My tears have been my food day and night, While "**they**" continually say to me, "Where is your God?" :4 When I remember these things, I pour out my soul within me. **For I used to go** with the multitude; I went with them to the house of God, With the voice of joy and praise, With a multitude that kept a pilgrim feast. :5 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him For the help of His countenance.

Psalm 18:33

He makes my feet like the *feet of deer*, And sets me on my high places.

The Bible Says - Psalm 16:8-9

I have set the LORD always before me; Because *He is* at my right hand I shall not be moved. :9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; My flesh also will rest in hope.

Set / shavah, *shaw-vaw'*;

to bring to level, to equalize; figuratively, to adjust to counterbalance,

2 Samuel 22:32-34

For who is God besides the LORD? And who is the Rock except our God? :33 It is God who arms me with strength and makes my way perfect. :34 **He makes my feet like the feet of a deer; he enables me to stand on the heights.**

DEVELOPING MATURITY IN THE DIFFICULTY

2c.) Difficulty develops love

By love I mean, understanding that in your suffering;
:He loves you"

He's No Voodoo God -

It's in those times of difficulty that real love comes to our aid.

The Bible Says – 1 Peter 4:12-14

Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; :13 but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. :14 If you are reproached for the name of Christ, *blessed are you*, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you.

The Bible Says

Him - whom having not seen, you love. Though now you do not see *Him*, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory,

1 Peter 1:8

The Bible Says - Psalm 34:17

The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears, And delivers them out of all their troubles. :18 The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart, And saves such as have a contrite spirit. :19 Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the LORD delivers him out of them all.

3.) Distributing life through the difficulty

Christian - The "Lordship" of Jesus Christ

Is defined by our submission to His rule & reign in the kingdom of our hearts and minds.

Matthew 16:24-26 – The Bible Says

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. :25 For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it. :26 For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?"

Have you ever thought that Life could actually have a **"Perfect Purpose"**
- - *it's realized in the ending* - -

DISTRIBUTING LIFE THROUGH THE DIFFICULTY

3a.) The life of Jesus is experienced thru the difficulty

Jesus Said - John 16:33

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

Keys and Combinations unlock Doors and Windows.

And difficulties are God's keys and combinations that unlock to us more of God.

2 Timothy 4:16-17

At my first defense no one stood with me, but all forsook me. May it not be charged against them. :17 But the Lord stood with me and strengthened me, so that the message might be preached fully through me, and *that* all the Gentiles might hear. Also I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion.

DISTRIBUTING LIFE THROUGH THE DIFFICULTY

3b.) The life of Jesus is known in the difficulty

The Bible Says

Therefore be imitators of God as dear children. :2 And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.

Ephesians 5:1-2

2 Corinthians 2:14-16a – The Bible Says

Now thanks *be* to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. :15 For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing. :16 To the one *we are* the aroma of death *leading* to death, and to the other the aroma of life *leading* to life...

DISTRIBUTING LIFE THROUGH THE DIFFICULTY

3c.) The life of Jesus is depended upon in the difficulty

Jesus Said - Revelation 1-2

saying, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last," and, "What you see, write in a book and send *it* to the seven churches which are in Asia..."

Revelation 2:8

"And to the angel of the church in **Smyrna** write, 'These things says the First and the Last, who was dead, and came back to life :9 "I know your works, tribulation, and poverty... :10 Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer... Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

Smyrna - meaning "*myrrh*" meaning "*bitter*."
Bitter to handle but sweet after its **crushed**.

Myrrh, a tree-based resin has, to the taste, a bitterness but once **crushed** and was used as a perfume or an incense aromatic. It was often used as a preservative in burial. In middle east cultures It is a symbol of death. It is worthy to note that it was one of the three gifts brought to Jesus Christ by the Wise Men. (See Matthew 2:11) All three gifts pictured something about the Messiahship of Jesus Christ and His mission. The **gold** symbolized His deity and His kingship; the **frankincense** symbolized His priesthood and His offering of Himself for sin, which was a sweet-smelling savior to our Heavenly Father (Ephesians 5:2); and the **myrrh** symbolized His suffering and death on the cross.

Here in - is the secret to

THE DISCIPLINE OF DIFFICULTY

It's recognizing your handicaps and weakness in the sight of an Almighty God and that those vary weakness become your place of victory with Christ.

1. It is to receive encouragement and then getting up and facing the issues.
2. It's putting on your "war face", going forth while looking for his protection.
3. It's the total realization that we're all, already dead to the world – so live !

It's Time to Acknowledge Our Difficulty's

By bring them to the altar, by thanking Him for it, by embracing Him with it.
