The better sacrifice, atonement, salvation, redemption, sanctification, justification.

Good Evening Church - Ya Wanna Hear Some Good?

Before I give it to you, I would like you to look around this world and tell me, what do you see? Pain. Fear. Sorrow. Sickness, etc.... would you agree that there's been a rapid, global, increase in hatred against what is good – against Christians, the Bible and God and all that is good?

But before we get started, I wanted to remind all of you - who are followers of the Lord Jesus Christ,

Matthew 18:20

For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”

John 16:33

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer (*do not let it get inside of you*), I have overcome the world.”

Because of His truth and His power – we're seeing really awesome things come to pass in this world – in real time – to the glory of God!

The Fruit of the Spirit in Action today - as we see Jesus on the Move!

“His love, His joy, His peace, His longsuffering, His kindness, His goodness, His faithfulness, His gentleness, His self-control.” – *is being seen!!!*

1.) Because there is no greater messenger

vs. 5-7a

Verse 5

Hebrews 2:5

5 For He (The Father) has not put the world to come, of which we speak, in subjection to angels.

Verse 6

Hebrews 2:6

But one (being David) testified in a certain place, saying: *“What is man that You are mindful of him, or the son of man that You take care of him?”*

Verse 7a

Hebrews 2:7

You have made him a little lower than the angels;

made

grk: ekane;

to put together, to piece together, assemble, fashion, prepare.

The Physical Conception & Physical Creation of the Eternal Son of God.

For thousands of years the Jews had been puzzled about this passage below – “what could it possibly mean?” because its meaning on the surface was just too fantastic.

Psalm 110:1-2

The LORD (my god) said to my Lord (my Savior), “Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool.” 2 The LORD (my God) shall send the Rod of Your strength (my Savior) out of Zion. (Jerusalem)

Do not let the dialogue confuse you. There are three personalities in this Scripture that are engaged in concert.

#1 is obviously King David who writes it down. David declares that the LORD #2 (is his Salvation = LORD = YAH) is speaking. David thus records what his LORD = YAH is saying to his Lord (David’s descendent); “Sit at My right hand till I make Your enemies Your footstool”

So said the Lord to... “David, you’re going to have a human descendant in the distant future. He will be your Lord and I as well “will call Him LORD” because He is the Lord. And because He is who He is; I promised Him - that He will be seated at My right hand of power forever and He will rule and reign for Eternity.”

2.) Because there is no greater representative

vs. 7b-8

Verse 7b

7b You have crowned him with glory and honor, and set him over the works of Your hands.

- crowned** grk: stephanoo;
to be crowned, the victor who wins the prize.
- glory** grk: doxa;
praise, due to being approved, found perfect, brightness,
radiance, majestic
- honor** grk: time;
precious, prized, the total sum of.
- set** grk: kathistemi;
to set in order, appoint, conducted, put in charge.

Verse 8

8 *You have put all things in subjection under his feet.*” For in that He put all in subjection under him, He left nothing that is not put under him.
But now we do not yet see all things put under him.

- Under** grk: hupokato;
to take out or from and to place below another or others. to put below or under. to place beneath, (ie. angels)
- Yet** grk: oupo;
not at this time, not now, not yet but soon, a time to come.

3.) Because there is no greater guide

vs. 9-10

Verse 9a

9a But we see Jesus

But We See Jesus – *but do you see Jesus?*

- see** grk: blepo;
to look at or to be fixed upon. to behold, to consider or to be face to face with Jesus.

9b who was made a little lower than the angels,
for the suffering of death

Why didn't Jesus come to us as an angel? #1 Because angels were not created in the image of God and #2 Angels, once having been created, do not die. #3 An angel could not have paid the sin-debt (fine) for our sins.

crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.

taste grk: geuomai,
to enter into our death, to "drink the poison" as it were, to not only do that but to plan on doing it, look forward to doing it, was delighted to do it = all because of His infinite love for Angels? No – for us humans.

But do you see Jesus?

Isaiah 48:12

"Listen to Me, O Jacob, and Israel, My called: I am He, I am the First, I am also the Last."

Isaiah 44:6

"Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel, and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: 'I am the First and I am the Last; besides Me there is no God.' "

Isaiah 41:4

"Who has performed and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? 'I, the LORD, am the first; and with the last I am He.'"

Isaiah 43:10

10a For it was fitting for Him,

fitting grk: prepo;
to see clearly to mission or cause, to see the reason for it.
implying that the love of God must do, act, perform or execute.

Verse 10a

10b FOR whom are all things and BY whom are all things,

Colossians 1:16-17

For by Him (Jesus) all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him (Jesus) and for Him (Jesus). 17 And He (Jesus) is before all things, and in Him (Jesus) all things consist of.

Verse 10c

10c in bringing many sons to glory,
to make the Captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings

bringing grk: ago;
to lead or to bring, to pull towards or to carry along.

captain grk: ar'che'gos;
the founder, forerunner, the one who leads or was and is the leader, the pioneer (of salvation).

An Archegos is one who leads the way so that others can follow. Also being translated "trailblazer," "scout," or "pioneer," "the one who points or the point-man" thus indicating one who **leads into battle**, blazes a trail, sets the course or marks the path, one who initiates and guides others to the indented destination.

Dr. William Barclay tells of a situation where “a ship was seen, foundering upon the rocks when suddenly one of its crew jumps overboard with a rope and swims ashore, securing the line so that others are able to grab onto the rope and come to safety. This one who did such a thing is the original, guiding, way-maker, the Ar’che’gos.”

truth in love - a hard verse for a catholic to hear

Verse 10d

10d to make the Captain of their salvation

Perfect

grk: teleioo;

meaning to send information down a wire or path or down range to the intended terminus (target) or end point, to finish with the completion of by ending or landing, to bring to completion, to accomplish what was planned.

vs. 11-13

11 For both He who sanctifies and those who
are being sanctified are all of one,

United. Unified. Bound. Amalgamation or
The Coming Together as One.

sanctifies

grk: ha’gi’azo;

to make that which is tainted or impure or unholy - holy,
consecrated, set apart from and set toward or in.

I Believe That The Most Profound Act of Oneness or Unity is...

John 10:27-29

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. 28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of My Father’s hand.

Verse 11b

for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren, 12 saying: *"I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will sing praise to You."* quoting Psalm 22:22 13 And again: *"I will put My trust in Him."* quoting Psalms 31:1 And again: *"Here am I and the children whom God has given Me."* quoting Isaiah 8:18

- ashamed** grk: epa'l'schuno'mai;
NOT to be ashamed of, NO embarrassment on God's part.
- brethren** grk: a'del'phos;
brothers, friends, close ones, family
- assembly** grk: ekkle'sia;
an assembly of those united in purpose, a citizen, a community,
a gathering, a congregation, the church.
