### THE TITLE OF THE MESSAGE:

## **“The Suicide Of Unbelief”**

In everything, the book of Hebrews presents Jesus Christ as the all sufficient and eternal priest. In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the law, being centrality of those ministries.

**The better sacrifice, atonement, salvation, redemption, sanctification, justification.**

### Hebrews 3:7-19

Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: *“Today, if you will hear His voice, 8 Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, in the day of trial in the wilderness, 9 where your fathers tested Me, tried Me, and saw My works forty years. 10 Therefore I was angry with that generation, and said, “They always go astray in their heart, and they have not known My ways.’ 11 So I swore in My wrath, “They shall not enter My rest.’ ” 12 Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; 13 but exhort one another daily, while it is called “Today,” lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. 14 For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end, 15 while it is said: “Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.” 16 For who, having heard, rebelled? Indeed, was it not all who came out of Egypt, led by Moses? 17 Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness? 18 And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey? 19 So we see that they could (would) not enter in because of unbelief.*

The increasing danger of unbelief in the human soul.

## **“The Suicide of Unbelief”**

### **unbelief**

grk: api'stia

Willful resistance to believing, the decision to not believe. To have “unbelief” is the root of apostasy. The act of abandoning one’s faith or belief, to go away from or to turn away from believing.

Apostacy is happening at a rate like never before in history.

And when Apostacy is afoot, this is what you will observe  
in what is called the church...

2 Timothy 3:1-5

But know this, that in the Last Days perilous times will come: 2 For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, 4 traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 having a form of godliness (tares, false believers) but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

Titus 1:16

They profess to know God, but in works (lifestyle) they deny Him, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.

Matthew 7:15

“Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.

Matthew 13:38-40

The field is the world, the good seeds are the sons of the kingdom, but the tares are the sons of the wicked one. 39 The enemy who sowed them is the devil, the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels. 40 Therefore as the tares are gathered and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of this age.

1 Timothy 5:8

But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

Titus 3:10

Reject a divisive man after the first and second admonition,

But shun profane and idle babblings, for they will increase to more ungodliness.

But avoid foolish and ignorant disputes, knowing that they generate strife.

### 1/11.) The Holy Spirit is God

The Holy Spirit is God  
(being the third person of the Trinity)

2 Peter 1:20-21

Knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, 21 for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 2:9-10

But as it is written: “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.” 10 But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.

### 1/12.) The Holy Spirit speaks

The Holy Spirit speaks

Acts 13:2-4

As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, “*Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.*” 3 Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away. 4 So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia, and from there they sailed to Cyprus.

### 1/13. The Holy Spirit is our Teacher

The Holy Spirit is our teacher.

John 14:25-26

“These things I have spoken to you while being present with you. 26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

1 John 2:20,27

But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things. 27 But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as He has taught you, you will abide in Him.

1/14.) The Holy Spirit can be (is) experienced

The Holy Spirit can be experienced.  
(before salvation / at salvation / for service)

2 Corinthians 3:17

Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

Romans 8:14-16

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father.” 16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

1/15.) The Holy Spirit is the Restrainer

The Holy Spirit restrains evil in the world.

John 16:7-11

Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. 8 And when He has come, He will (1) convict the world of sin, and (2) of righteousness, and (3) of judgment: 9 (1) of sin, because they do not believe in Me; 10 (2) of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; 11 and (3) of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

2 Thessalonians 2:5-8

Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you these things? 6 And now you know what is restraining, that he may be revealed in his own time. 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way. 8 And then the lawless one will be revealed,

Matthew 5:13-16

“You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. 14 “You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

1/16.) The Holy Spirit will present the Church to Christ

The Holy Spirit will deliver the church to Jesus Christ  
at the Moment of the Rapture.

This is one of the many reasons why there’s a Rapture of the Church.  
The Holy Spirit is the Responsible member of the Trinity that is preparing.

Titus 3:4-7

But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, 5 not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, 6 whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior, 7 that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

**“The Suicide Of Unbelief”**  
And The Holy Spirit

1/17.) The Holy Spirit will be poured out on Israel’s remnant

Following the Rapture and During the Tribulation Period –  
The Holy Spirit will be poured out on the Remnant of Believing Israel.  
( just as He did when Israel was to Preach Jesus Christ )

Joel 2:28-32

“And it shall come to pass afterward that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions. 29 And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days. 30 “And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth: blood and fire and pillars of smoke. 31 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the coming of the great and awesome day of the LORD. 32 And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the LORD has said, among the remnant whom the LORD calls.

**In The Book of Revelation there are the Judgements of God**

appointed to come against the earth. There are three specific “Judgements” known as the:

**(7) Seals (7) Trumpets (7) Bowls Judgements**

After the **6<sup>th</sup> Seal** begins but before the **7<sup>th</sup> Seal** is opened

Revelation 7:1-4, 14:1-4

After these things I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, on the sea, or on any tree. 2 Then I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God. And he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea, 3 saying, “Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads.” 4 And I heard the number of those who were sealed. One hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel were sealed... 14:1 Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father’s name written on their foreheads. 2 And I heard a voice from heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps. 3 They sang as it were a new song before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except the hundred and forty-four thousand who were redeemed from the earth. 4 These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes.

The 144,000 are Virgin Hebrew Men,  
12,000 from Each of the Hebrew Tribes of Israel
