THE TITLE OF THE MESSAGE:

“No Pastor, Priest, Pope Or King”

In everything, the book of Hebrews presents Jesus Christ as the all-sufficient and eternal priest. In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the law, being centrality of those ministries.

SUBJECT TOPICALLY REFERENCED UNDER:

rest, atonement, salvation, redemption, sanctification, justification.

Throughout the Bible, there are several encounters that are recorded where God allows Himself to be experienced in such a profound and intimate manner that the result is beyond human means.

Abraham, Moses, Joshua, Manoah, Daniel, Isaiah, Ezekiel, & Mary...

Galatians 4:4-5

But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

The promised **prophecies** had arrived / **Incarnation** appeared /
While the **Law** was in effect & while Israel was under **Occupation** /
Granting an **Unalienable Right – Adoption!**

1 Timothy 3:16

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: (1) God was manifested in the flesh, (2) justified in the Spirit, (3) seen by angels, (4) preached among the Gentiles, (5) believed on in the world, (6) received up in glory.

So that God’s Eternal Plan might (perhaps) Include You

*Abraham, Moses, Joshua, Manoah, Daniel,
Isaiah, Ezekiel, Mary & Your Name Here.*

An Example for Us;

Exodus 3:1-5

Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian. And he led the flock to the back of the desert, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. 2 And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed. 3 Then Moses said, *“I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn.”* 4 So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, *“Moses, Moses!”* And he said, *“Here I am.”* 5 Then He said, *“Do not draw near this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground.”*

An Example for Us;

Joshua 5:13-15

And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, a Man stood opposite him with His sword drawn in His hand. And Joshua went to Him and said to Him, *“Are You for us or for our adversaries?”* 14 So He said, *“No, but as Commander of the army of the LORD I have now come.”* And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshiped, and said to Him, *“What does my Lord say to His servant?”* 15 Then the Commander of the LORD’S army said to Joshua, *“Take your sandal off your foot, for the place where you stand is holy.”* And Joshua did so.

Another Big Example for Us;

1 Timothy 2:5

For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus,

men / Man grk: anthropos
humankind, man, mankind, a person, a friend.

Whoever the God of the Bible is;

(1) He is **One singular**. (2) He is The Anthropos Man *singular*,
(3) He is The Christ *singular*, (4) He is Salvation *singular*.

Hebrew 9:13-15

For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, 14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the Eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? 15 And for this reason He is the Mediator of the New Covenant,

And So - Let's All Stand For Our Congregational Reading

Hebrews 4:14-16

Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. 15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Can Compare To The Lord Jesus Christ

1a.) He is the totality of God revealed

vs. 14a

Verse 14a

Hebrews 4:14 NKJV

Seeing then

The ESV translates the word here as... “Since Then”

The NLT translates the word here as... “So Then”

The NIV translates the word here as... “Therefore Since”

The Darby translates the word here as... “Having Therefore”

then

grk: *oun*

wherefore or therefore, however, now – *meaning now that you know what has always been – run in the knowledge of it.*

“We now enter into the bulk and purpose of the writing of

the Book of Hebrews. The Foundational Doctrines have been poured out as concrete showing us that God is knowable, relatable, and unshakable.”

Hebrews 1:1-3

God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, 2 has in these last days spoken to us by His Son. 3 who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

Hebrews 2:1-3

Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away. 2 For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward, 3 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation,

Hebrews 3:1-4, 12-13

Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus, 2 who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house. 3 For this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house. 4 For every house is built by someone, but He who built all things is God... 12 Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; 13 but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

Hebrews 4:1,11-12a

Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it... 11 Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience. 12a For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword,

John 16:5-7,13-14

"But now I go away to Him who sent Me, and none of you asks Me, 'Where are You going?' 6 But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. 7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you, 13 However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. 14 He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you.

John 14:16-18

And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever - 17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. 18 I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.
