THE TITLE OF THE MESSAGE:

“Just Give Me Jesus” – Part 3

In everything, the book of Hebrews presents Jesus Christ as the all-sufficient and eternal priest. In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the law, being centrality of those ministries.

SUBJECT TOPICALLY REFERENCED UNDER:

rest, atonement, salvation, redemption, sanctification, justification.

Hebrews 5:6-11

As He also says in another place: “You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek”; 7 Who, {Jesus Christ} in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear, 8 though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered. 9 And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him, 10 called by God as High Priest “according to the order of Melchizedek,” 11 of whom we have much to say, and hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing.

Ya Wanna Know a Secret That Can be Known by Everybody?
We are on the brink of what will become the world’s greatest controversy (one among many regarding Christ, The Bible and the things coming upon this world)

“At This Prophetic Hour in the World Today
by all accounts, and I do mean by all accounts - the Church as we see it and know it on earth - is in her sunset hours as she is waning and diming from off the world stage – an observable and obvious fact. The “Church” is a diminish influence. It’s true witness has become scarce in the earth (West). Yet all of this is prophetically necessary and taught in the Bible, why? Because the true church must be

separated out and away from the false church and that is visible today as well as the fact that the true body of believers (the remnant) must soon be departing from this world in what is seen in many scriptures that will itself become a global controversy....”

John 14:1-3

“Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. :2 In My Father’s house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. :3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. :14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. :15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. :16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. :18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.

1a.) He is the epicenter of all theology

vs. 6a

As He also says in another place:

“You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek”;

Here, the author of Hebrews quotes Psalm 110:4 when speaking of the Messiah of the World...

Psalm 110:4

The LORD has sworn and will not relent,
“You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.”

By doing so, the author connects the ministry of Jesus Christ and His existence to the personage / personification named Melchi (king) Zedek (righteousness).

The name “Melchizedek” is a compound name from 2 Hebrew words. Malak meaning King and Zedek meaning Righteousness.

Genesis 14:18

Then Melchi (king) Zedek (righteousness) king of Salem (peace)

A Christophanies or Theophanies =
a pre-incarnate appearance of Jesus Christ prior to the Bethlehem event.

“Just Give Me Jesus” Considering Who He Is

1b.) He is the focal point of all future hope

vs. 6b

Abraham Hoped in the Coming Messiah.

There was no physical or national Israel yet.
There was no physical Jerusalem as yet – only Salem.

John 8:54-56

Jesus answered, “If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing. It is My Father who honors Me, of whom you say that He is your God. 55 Yet you have not known Him, but I know Him. And if I say, “I do not know Him,’ I shall be a liar like you; but I do know Him and keep His word. 56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad.”

Do Not Miss This !

There’s a lot of “remarkable” going on here - but the most telling thing of all - is how his antagonists understood what it was Jesus was saying...

John 8:57-58

Then the Jews said to Him, “You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?” 58 Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, (prior to Abraham ever being born) I AM.”

Exodus 3:13-14

Then Moses said to God, "Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they say to me, 'What is His name?' what shall I say to them?" 14 And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

John 10:25-33

Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. 26 But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. 27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. 28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. 30 I and My Father are One." 31 Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. 32 Jesus answered them, "Many good works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?" 33 The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God."

1c.) He is the consummation of all the Scriptures

vs. 6c

A Coincidence? – No Way!

It is interesting to note that - once we're introduced to Melchizedek we see that He is recognized as a person of higher spiritual standing than any prophet, priest or priesthood & he out-ranks even Abraham, the man known to be "the friend of God"

The Location of Salem is not in Doubt.

Psalm 76:1-2

In Judah God is known; His name is Great in Israel.
2 In Salem also is His tabernacle, and His dwelling place in Zion.

Isaiah 9:6-7

For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. 7 Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

Psalm 110:1-6

(a Psalm of David)

The LORD (YAH) said to my Lord (MASTER) "Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool." 2 The LORD (YAH) shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies! 3 Your people shall be volunteers in the day of Your power; in the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth. 4 The LORD (YAH) has sworn and will not relent, "You are a Priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek." 5 The Lord (MASTER) is at Your right hand; He (Lord (MASTER)) shall execute kings in the day of His (Lord (MASTER)) wrath. 6 He (Lord (MASTER)) shall judge among the nations, He (Lord (MASTER)) shall fill the places with dead bodies, He (Lord (MASTER)) shall execute the heads of many countries.

This is 100% consistent with the Biblical argument for the Deity of Jesus Christ and His Second Coming to earth to establish His Kingdom rule.

Isaiah 26:19-21

Your dead shall live; together with My dead body they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; for your dew is like the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead. 20 Come, My people, enter your chambers, and shut your doors behind you; hide yourself, as it were, for a little moment, until the indignation is past. 21 For behold, The LORD (YAH) comes out of His place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity; the earth will also disclose her blood (reveal the dead), and will no more cover her slain.

What Will It Look Like ?

Isaiah 59:17-20

For He puts on righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of salvation on His head; He puts on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloak. 18 According to their deeds, accordingly - He will repay fury to His adversaries, recompense to His enemies; the coastlands He will fully repay. 19 So shall they fear the Name of The LORD (YAH) from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun (East); when the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD will lift up a Standard against him. 20 "The Redeemer will come to Zion, and to those who turn from transgression in Jacob," says the LORD.

The Redeemer Will Come to Zion !

Psalm 50:1-6

The Mighty One, God the LORD, has spoken and called the earth from the rising of the sun (east) to its going down (west) . 2 Out of Zion, the Perfection of Beauty, God will shine forth. 3 Our God shall come (physically), and shall not keep silent; a fire shall devour before Him, and it shall be very tempestuous all around Him. 4 He shall call to the heavens from above, and

to the earth, that He may judge His people: 5 “Gather My saints together to Me, those who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice.” 6 Let the heavens declare His righteousness, for God Himself is Judge.

Isaiah 63:1-4

Who is this who comes from Edom, with dyed (stained) garments from Bozrah, (East) this One who is glorious in His apparel, traveling in the greatness of His strength? - “I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save.” 2 Why is Your apparel red, and Your garments like one who treads in the winepress? 3 “I have trodden the winepress alone, and from the peoples no one was with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger, and trampled them in My fury; their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, and I have stained all My robes. 4 For the day of vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed (Israel) has come.

And This Is How Your New Testament Records It

Revelation 1:7-8

Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen. 8 “I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End,” says the Lord, “who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.”

Matthew 24:27-31

For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. 28 For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together. 29 “Immediately after the tribulation of those days (1) the sun will be darkened, and (2) the moon will not give its light; (3) the stars will fall from heaven, and (4) the powers of the heavens will be shaken. 30 (5) Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and (6) then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and (7) they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and (8) great glory. 31 (9) And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and (10) they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other (from one end of the earth to the other end of the earth).

Revelation 19:1-19

After these things (meta tauta) I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, “Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God! 2 For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her.” 3 Again they said, “Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!” 4 And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on the throne, saying, “Amen! Alleluia!” 5 Then a voice came from the throne, saying, “Praise our God, all you His servants and those who fear Him, both small and great!” 6 And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings,

saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! 7 Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." 8 And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. 9 Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!'" And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God." 10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." 11 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. 12 His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. 13 He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. 15 Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS. 17 Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great God, 18 that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great." 19 And I saw the beast (666), the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.

As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. 16 And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock and one shepherd. 17 "Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. 18 No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father."

Philippians 2:5b-8

Christ Jesus, 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

John 5:37-39

37 And the Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form. 38 But you do not have His word abiding in you, because whom He sent, Him you do not believe. 39 You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me.

Just as He did on resurrection Sunday Evening...

Luke 24:44-45

Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." 45 And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.

John 5:40

But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life.
