THE TITLE OF THE MESSAGE:

In everything, the book of Hebrews presents Jesus Christ as the all-sufficient and eternal priest. In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the law, being centrality of those ministries.

I believe that we're here tonight because we may be in the opening throws of a coming revival in the United States.

But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood. 25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

Perfected grk: teleioo
to bring to an end, to bring to completion or to accomplish, to finish or to have fulfilled.

Author grk: aitios
the causative act or originator, the causation or the one responsible for, source

Obey grk: hupakouo
to listen to, to attend to, to answer to.

Dull grk: no'thros
sluggish, slothful, slow moving, plugged up, a lazy worker.

You have become lazy at listening.
Spiritual ADD is a dangerous affliction.

Mental drifting is a battle and drifting off leads to spiritual dullness.
It is only by applying the Word to yourself that you
grow spiritually.

Luke 8:18

Therefore take heed how you hear. For whoever has, to him more will be given; and whoever does not have, even what he seems to have will be taken from him."

Partakes grk: metecho
to share in or to exchange in.

Unskilled grk: apeiros
not knowing what to do in a situation, to freeze or to sit motionless.
without experience, not being accustomed to.

2 Timothy 3:5-8a

Having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away! 6 For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts, 7 always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. 8a Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the faith;

- Babe** grk: nepios
Infantile, a simple-minded or immature person, childish in thought, emotion and actions.
- Full Age** grk: teleioo
to bring to an end, to bring to completion or to accomplish, to finish or to have fulfilled.
- Reason** grk: dia
on account of, because of
- Senses** grk: aistheterion
Perception, an internal awareness of what is right or wrong, to know what to do, say or go toward or away from.
- Discern** grk: gumnazo
to exercise naked, to train stripped of liability, the meaning is to have nothing or to provide nothing that the enemy can grab on to.

2 Corinthians 6:14-18, 7:1

Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? 15 And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? 16 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people." 17 Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord.
