THE TITLE OF THE MESSAGE:

“Who Are Those Who Can Never Be Saved?” – Part 2

In everything, the book of Hebrews presents Jesus Christ as the all-sufficient and eternal priest. In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the law, being centrality of those ministries.

Hebrews 6:1-3

Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. 3 And this we will do if God permits.

Hebrews 6:4-6

For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit, 5 and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, 6 if they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame.

1.) Those who put themselves in an impossible situation vs. 4

Hebrews 6:4

For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit,

1a.) They were looking back to the past vs. 4a

For it is impossible for those

Impossible grk: adunatos
unable, powerless, without a path or course, having no other place to go. (having become adrift with no place to anchor to)

1b.) They were able to know the difference

vs. 4b

who were once enlightened,

once grk: hapax
exposed, having had an encounter, or having had an experience, to become aware of what is.

enlightened grk: photizo
to shine upon, to give light to, to be brought to light, to be illuminated (chiefly by proximity as being near to or close to the source of light)

1 John 2:18-19

Little children, it is the last hour; and as you have heard that the Antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have come, by which we know that it is the last hour. 19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us; but they went out that they might be made manifest, that none of them were of us.

1c.) They were familiar with church life

vs. 4c

and have tasted the heavenly gift,

tasted grk: geuomai
to flavor or to taste, to know the taste of something or to have tasted this or that thing, to be knowledgeable of the taste.

heavenly grk: epouranios
broad meaning pertaining to the heavenly attributes of all things regarding the characteristics and experiences both in heaven and on earth regarding spiritual matters of the kingdom life.

gift grk: dorea
without charge, free, gifted, given as in bestowed upon, to be
gifted the things or a thing that cannot be gotten any other way.

1d.) They were content to be an outsider vs. 4d

and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit,

partakers grk: metochos
to be sharing in or companions with another along the way or
during an event, to witness the same thing(s), to see the same
thing(s) to be present at the same moment as others.

Diagnostics

The Holy Spirit who is the focal point of the issue.
Whoever these people are – they witnessed the moving of the Holy Spirit in
some fashion so as to leave them without an excuse.
>>>> In other words – God did His part to reveal Himself to them <<<<
