THE TITLE OF THE MESSAGE:

## **“Who Are Those Who Can Never Be Saved?” – Part 3**

In everything, the book of Hebrews presents Jesus Christ as the all-sufficient and eternal priest. In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the law, being centrality of those ministries.

SUBJECT TOPICALLY REFERENCED UNDER:

**rest, atonement, salvation, redemption, sanctification, justification.**

Hebrews 6:1-6

Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. 3 And this we will do if God permits. 4 For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit, 5 and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, 6 if they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame.

(1) Many people will argue over this issue of Salvation and can it be lost? (2) Is it secured for those who trust Christ? (3) Will I actually make it to heaven? (4) How can I be sure?

1 John 5:11-13

And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. 12 He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. 13 These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God.

# Full Assurance of Salvation – FULL!

There are no viable arguments to contradict this verse. But the Scriptures continue on with this blessed promise of FULL ASSURANCE.

John 10:28-30

And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. 30 I and My Father are one."

Jesus said, "I Give Them Eternal Life!" He said, "They Shall Never Perish!"  
Jesus said, "Neither Can They be Snatched Out of My Hand!" Jesus said,  
"Nor Can They be Snatched Out of My Father's Hand!"

3a.) They are those who reject the hope of eternal life

vs. 6a

If they fall away

If they turn from all that they have come to know and have experienced and witnessed, If they should fall away – it only proves that they didn’t take all these things to heart.

Luke 8:11-13

“Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. 12 Those by the wayside are the ones who hear; then the devil comes and takes away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. 13 But the ones on the rock are those who, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of temptation fall away.

Matthew 7:13-14

“Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. 14 Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Matthew 7:19-20

Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. 20 Therefore by their fruits you will know them. 21 “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. 22 Many will say to Me in that day, “Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ 23 And then I will declare to them, “I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’

**God’s commitment to save us, causes us to continue on**

Philippians 1:6

being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun (past tense) a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

Romans 8:38-39

For I am persuaded (past tense) that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, :39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:29-30

For whom He foreknew, (past tense) He also predestined, (past tense) to be conformed, (past tense) to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. :30 Moreover whom He predestined, (past tense) these He also called; (past tense) whom He called, (past tense) these He also justified; (past tense) and whom He justified, (past tense) these He also glorified. (past tense)

1 Peter 1:3-5

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten (past tense) us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, (past tense) :4 to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled (past tense) and that does not fade away, reserved (past tense) in heaven for you, 5 who are kept (past tense) by the power of God.

Ephesians 1:13

In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed (past tense) with the Holy Spirit of promise,

Hebrews 7:25

Therefore, He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

Matthew 24:24

(in the coming great tribulation)

"For false Christ's and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, (meaning it is impossible) even the elect.

Jude 1:24-25a & Titus 2:13-14

Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy, 25a To the only wise God our Savior... 13 Looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, 14 who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

3b.) They are those who return to themselves for themselves

vs. 6b

to renew them again to repentance, (would be impossible)

**Renew**

grk: anakainizo

to renew as an attempt to make what is new, new again. the thrust of the meaning is that once you have been made new there is no need to be made new again. this verse puts into question the authenticity of the individual ever having been made new in the first place.

**Repentance**

grk: metanoia

to change the mind or the way or the direction in which someone or something is headed. To change course a full 180 degrees.

**All dressed up with no place to go.**

Hebrews 10:1

For the law..... being a shadow of the good things to come.... is not the very image of those things.... which can never with these sacrifices.... which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach complete or acceptable.

**All dressed up with nothing left.**

Colossians 2:16-17

So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, 17 which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ.

# "IT'S IMPOSSIBLE BECAUSE"

## **this is the Unpardonable Sin**

In The Gospel of Matthew 12  
The Religious Pharisees are Perfect Examples of This

Matthew 12:30-32

"He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad. 31 "Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven men. 32 "Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come.

## To Resist the Wooing of the Holy Spirit

is to sin against the Holy Spirit..... to come to the moment of death and to die resisting the wooing of the Holy Spirit is to Commit the Unpardonable Sin -- Never to be forgiven!!!

John 8:24

"Therefore, I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sins."

## Peter's Comment About the Same

2 Peter 2:20

For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning.

2 Thessalonians 2:1-13

Now, brethren, concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, we ask you, 2 not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the day of Christ had come. 3 Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first { , } and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, 4 who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God. 5 Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you these things? 6 And now you know what is restraining, that he may be revealed in his own time. 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the

way. 8 And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming. 9 The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, 10 and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this reason God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, 12 that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness. 13 But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth,
