THE TITLE OF THE MESSAGE:

WHY NOT HAVE THE BEST!

In everything, the book of Hebrews presents Jesus Christ as the all-sufficient and eternal priest.
In all things Jesus Christ is better than Moses, than Angels, than the law, being centrality of those ministries.

SUBJECT TOPICALLY REFERENCED UNDER:

rest, hope, promises, oaths, immutability, blessings. God's faithfulness.

Hebrews 9:11-14

But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. 12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. 13 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, 14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the Eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Attention please – focus please – remember if you please;

(1) That there is the evidence of creation - everywhere. (2) That there is a marvel to our existence. (3) That within you is the desire to not only live – but to have meaning and purpose for your life.

Colossians 2:16-17

So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, 17 which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ.

WHY NOT HAVE THE BEST!

1.) When God's best is enough

vs. 11

But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation.

WHY NOT HAVE THE BEST WHEN GOD'S BEST IS ENOUGH

1a.) The Messiah as our High Priest is best

vs. 11a

But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come,

By definition – the Old Covenant was weak and unable

to provide salvation. It was never given to bring salvation - -
it was given to point you to salvation.

Hebrews 7:26

For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners,
and has become higher than the heavens.

< In His humanity, He Ascended back to Heaven
As our fully qualified, acceptable representative. >

1b.) The Best is all we've ever needed

vs. 11b

with the greater and more perfect tabernacle

greater

grk: meizon

abundant as in abounding, all the more greater, being the absolute

2 Corinthians 3:5

Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our
sufficiency is from God,

perfect

grk: teleios

having been sent with information - to reach the target or to finish the trajectory,
ending at the intended point.

Hebrews 8:1-2

Now this is the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at
the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, 2 a Minister of the sanctuary and of the
true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man.

1c.) The Realization of the Ages is enough

vs. 11c

not made with (human) hands, that is, not of this creation.

Looking at the absolute revealed transcendency
and centrality of who the person of Jesus Christ is from the Scriptures.

WHY NOT HAVE THE BEST - JESUS IS ENOUGH
