1b.) It's the evidence that God has preexisted before our world

Colossians 1:15-17

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. **16** For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. **17** And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.

#1 which you **have seen**,
(**things** that you (John) have **seen**.- past things - that which was before you)

2b.) Because it addresses **the present age**

#2 and the **things which are**,
(**things** that you (John) are **seeing now**.- present things - that you hear & see)

In Revelation Chapters 2-3

Why Is Bible Prophecy Important ?

2c.) Because it reveals **the future of history**

#3 and the **things which will** take place
The things after those things.
(**things** that you (John) **will see** – in the future. future things that you hear & see)

In Revelation Chapters 4:1 (2)-22:21

Revelation 4:1

After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, "Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place (meta tauta) after this."

Put On Your Prophetic Glasses

John 16:1-28

“These things I have spoken to you, that you should not be made to stumble. **2** They will put you out of the synagogues; yes, the time is coming that whoever kills you will think that he offers God service. **3** And these things they will do to you because they have not known the Father nor Me. **4** But these things I have told you, that when the time comes, you may remember that I told you of them. “And these things I did not say to you at the beginning, because I was with you. **5** “But now I go away to Him who sent Me, and none of you asks Me, ‘Where are You going?’ **6** But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. **7** Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. **8** And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: **9** of sin, because they do not believe in Me; **10** of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; **11** of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged. **12** “I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now. **13** However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. **14** He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare *it* to you. **15** All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore, I said that He will take of Mine and declare *it* to you. **16** “A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see Me, because I go to the Father.” **17** Then *some* of His disciples said among themselves, “What is this that He says to us, ‘A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see Me’; and, ‘because I go to the Father’ ?” **18** They said therefore, “What is this that He says, ‘A little while’? We do not know what He is saying.” **19** Now Jesus knew that they desired to ask Him, and He said to them, “Are you inquiring among yourselves about what I said, ‘A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see

Me'? **20** Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice; and you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy. **21** A woman, when she is in labor, has sorrow because her hour has come; but as soon as she has given birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish, for joy that a human being has been born into the world. **22** Therefore you now have sorrow; but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice, and your joy no one will take from you. **23** "And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. **24** Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full. **25** "These things I have spoken to you in figurative language; but the time is coming when I will no longer speak to you in figurative language, but I will tell you plainly about the Father. **26** In that day you will ask in My name, and I do not say to you that I shall pray the Father for you; **27** for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from God. **28** I came forth from the Father and have come into the world. Again, I leave the world and go to the Father."

3c.) The Danger of **Obsessing** on Biblical Prophecy

Experiment 101-A

I am about to give you an exhortation.

I am going to say something about the future, but not from any source of my own, but from the source of Scripture. I'm going to accurately say something about the future that will come to pass not because I am saying it, but because it is God's word given to us in advance.

"There is going to be an increasing in weird things being said and done in the name of Jesus Christ by allot of people. These people will be false prophets, false teachers and deceivers. They will teach false things and say false prophecies with such supernatural influence and charisma, that unless someone is grounded in biblical truth about these false believers, they themselves will be powerless against these spiritual powers and they will be deceived by them."

Matthew 24:24-25

For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. 25 See, I have told you beforehand.

Matthew 24:11

Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many.

Matthew 7:15

"Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.

2 Thessalonians 2:9-10

The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, 10 and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

Knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, 21 for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke *as they were* moved by the Holy Spirit. 2:1 But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, *and* bring on themselves swift destruction. 2 And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed.

“He’s the Antichrist or That Guy is the Antichrist”

The Church will Never Know Who the Antichrist is
while the church is on Earth

2 Thessalonians 2:1-8a

Now, brethren, concerning (#1) the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, we ask you, 2 not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the Day of Christ had come (that the rapture had happened and the tribulation has begun) 3 Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin (A/C) is revealed, the son of perdition (A/C)...

4 who opposes and exalts himself (A/C) above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits (A/C) as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he (A/C) is God. 5 Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you these things? 6 And now you know (*remember*) what is **restraining**, that he (A/C) may be revealed in his (A/C) own time. 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; (*moving, advancing*) only He (*The Restrainer*) who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way (*stands aside*). 8 And then the lawless one (A/C) will be revealed.
