2 Peter 3:1-9

Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in both of which I stir up your pure minds by way of reminder), 2 that you may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us, the apostles of the Lord and Savior, 3 knowing this first: that scoffers will come in the last days, walking according to their own lusts, 4 and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of creation." 5 For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water, 6 by which the world that then existed perished, being flooded with water. 7 But the heavens and the earth which are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. :8 But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. 9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

2 Peter 3:10-13

But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. 11 Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness,12 looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? 13 Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation, 21 for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

3a.) Our Purpose is to invite them

vs. 12a

Verse 12a

THE **looking for** and THE **hastening** OF the coming of the day of God

I love this "Looking For" because it assumes that we are "underway like a ship at sea"

To be "Looking For" is to be searching for the next "Way-Point" along the Journey.

In Fact, This can only Apply to a Christian, Because it is the Christian who is a Pilgrim.

1 Peter 1:1

Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, To the pilgrims of the Dispersion (who at the moment are passing through) in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia,

You cannot be a Pilgrim unless you've left some place To go to some other place. to be a Pilgrim is to be looking for home.

A Pilgrim is not a Nomad.

A nomad is an aimless wanderer, a vagabond – The pilgrim scans the horizon looking for the home he has never been to physically.

Hebrews 11:8-10

By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. 9 By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise; 10 for he waited (in the land of promise – Abraham was still a pilgrim) for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God.

"Every true Christian looks for the coming of the Lord and that "expectation" drives them daily to live for Christ. This "expectancy" is not inactive but rather – active. It is the active-ness of the new heart and new life that is in Christ."

the coming of the day of God

this we know for sure - that we are not talking about the Rapture or even the Second Coming. We are talking about the time that will follow the of this earth at it's end

looking grk: prosdokao; from 4314 and dokeu/w (to watch); to await,

expect: —expect(2), expecting(2), look for(4), looking for(2), state of expectation(1), waited(1), waiting for(2), watching(1).

Hastening grk: speudo; a prim. word; *to hasten, urge on:* —hastening(1), hurry(1), hurrying(1), in haste(1), make haste(1).

the coming of the day of God

No one knows exactly how this is going to be fulfilled, but we know that it will be fulfilled. And here's what it is that in some way shape or form - God has allowed us the opportunity to hasten the coming of the Day of God.

But How is this exhortation to be received? (1) by how we wait. (2) by how we live. (3) By whom we proclaim,

So my lifestyle in concert with your lifestyle - - being lived for the glory of Jesus can hurry things up – Peter seems to be saying that the more obedient we are the quicker this thing can be over.

Peter's Urgency to Repeat – It's Ending! This is the ending of all things as we know it in this physical world.

We Are - To Be Ready?

It is to have a course and a purpose and direction and a meaning that drives your life and your living.

We Are - To Get Ready?

It is to see that your life is scattered and a bit aimless. It is to recognize that you really don't have much of a reason to live. And you want to change that.

We Are - To Stay Ready?

This is to cultivate, maintain, conduct yourself from the place of "readiness" it is to keep yourself "sharp" or alert while you are "at the wheel".

Personal Struggles = Life Savers

I am personally convinced that this is why some of us are almost always in a situation that "keeps us coming back to God"

For some it is **relational hardships** // For some it is **physical challenges**. For some it is **financial stress** // For others (like me) we need **a battle** to stay dependent upon God.

What can we expect if we are "ready" for what God wants next?

Expect Vision / Expect Courage.

Expect **Resilience** / Expect **Opposition**.

Expect Fruit / Expect Ministry.

Ministry to be Rewarded with More Ministry, which in return is rewarded with more Ministry.

What are the joys and the pleasures in this present world that point to us about what the new world coming will be like?

What about our **eyesight**? // What about how we **physically feel**? What about the **taste of food** or the **sound of music?** What about **conversations** and **relationships**?

Isaiah 65:17

"For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former shall not be remembered or come to mind.

We're moving. We decided to Relocate – to a better life.

We are to be living in the light of our new home.

Heaven is where Jesus is and He is going to make all things new, and you're going to be with Him, with us – forever!

1 Corinthians 2:9-10

But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, neither has it entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him.

10 But God has revealed them to us...

Our sanctified imagination / moments revelations.

Revelation 21:1-4

Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. 2 Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. 3 And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God. 4 And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. Romans 8:19-23 NLT

But with eager hope, **21** the creation looks forward to the day when it will join God's children in glorious freedom from death and decay. **22** For we know that all creation has been groaning (tiffy) as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time. **23** And we believers also groan, even though we have the Holy Spirit within us as a foretaste of future glory, for we long for our bodies to be released from sin and suffering. We, too (groaning like tiffy), wait with eager hope for the day when God will give us our full rights as his adopted children, a including the new bodies he has promised us.

Psalm 16:11

You will show me the path of life; in **Your presence is fullness of joy**; at Your right hand **are pleasures forevermore**.
